Advised Deputy Assistant Director, SO, of inability to attend SO Staff Conference this morning.

General Sibert reference Col. Ivan Yeaton, GSC, P&O Div., Army, Rm. 3D 819 Pentagon, x 73022---wanted to discuss psychological warfare activities. Later called on Deputy Director for discussion.

Director requested Deputy Director to lecture before the National War College sometime during March. Arrangements were made through Lt. Pennington, Aide to General Lemnitzer, for the Deputy Director to talk on "CIA and its Mission" at 1030 hours, 25 March 1948, restricted to War College students and the staff. The Deputy Director was invited to remain for lunch with Gen. Lemnitzer, staff officers and one or two of the committees for informal discussion. The Deputy Director stated he would need no visual aids prepared for use during the lecture.

Captain [ ] ORE, reference DCI request for study on synthetic rubber industry, and included therein was a section on synthetic rubber; advised that the study had been delivered to the Director.

Reference report made some time ago on the date when certain foreign countries could be expected to produce atomic weapons; there had been some difference of opinion on time element by A-2 and G-2; Deputy Director suggested that Col. [ ] of NEG discuss the paper with General Gruenther, Joint Staff, JCS.

General Sibert concerning liaison with NEG now that the Group has been moved from administrative control of ORE to OSO; Deputy Director stated there was no change in liaison with this Group.

Also queried if there would be implementing directive issued in connection with NSCID 7; Deputy Director stated that General Sibert should contact Chief, ICAPS, regarding the implementing DCID.
