- 1. Colonel Watson visited OSI on 22 Hovember 1949 for informal discussion, especially with reference to paragraph 2.j. of attached agreement.
 - 2. Copy of agreement was left with us.
- 3. It appears that the problem is largely within Air Force and between E-2, which is under Air Material Command and A-2. which is under Air Operations.
- A. We have a definite interest in seeing that T-2 analysts collaborate with ours and that T-2 has representation on appropriate scientific intelligence working committees. E-2 itself has been giving thought to the creation of committees and has done some production of intelligence in the fields of nuclear energy, BV, CV, and the like. It appears to us that the best way to prevent unnecessary duplication and to hook into the circuit the very real combilities of T-2 in the field of guided missiles, simpleme construction, and sero-dynamics is to work closely with them committee-wise.
- 5. A great proportion of the procedural requirements lie within the purview of OCD, 400
