1. "Factory" No 95 at Dresden - Gittersee is charged with ore mining and processing operations. The ore processing procedure is described as a pressing operation. A total of about 1,700 men including 150 men assigned to the boiler house were employed at the installation. Work was done in three shifts. The boiler house was equipped with five boilers of 40 atmospheres each.
