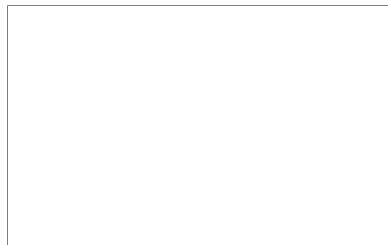

- As of late summer 1954, jet fighters with very sharply swept-back wings and larger propeller-driven aircraft were based on an airfield located on the southeastern edge of Baranovichi (N 53-08, E 26-02).<sup>1</sup> In the area of the airfield, [redacted] officers and enlisted men in Air Force uniforms. 50X1-HUM
- A kaserne composed of barracks type of buildings is located on Sovkhoznaya ulitsa in Baranovichi. This kaserne is occupied by a military unit (size not specified), whose officers and enlisted men wear uniforms denoting that they belong to the artillery branch of service.
- A small building on Sovetskaya ulitsa is occupied by uniformed women who are members of the communications service (Signal Troops).
