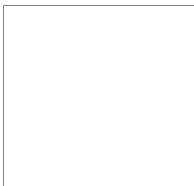

1. Although it has not been officially announced, some government institutions have stopped paying the high-cost-of-living bonus to residents of Sofia. This special bonus amounted to 10 percent of the basic salary and was paid to residents of Sofia only.
