Object 90

1. The Third Administration of the Soviet-German Company Wismut (AG Wismut) approved in January 1955 the following new installations of mechanical equipment at Site 85 of Object 90:
 - a. Haulage equipment, estimated cost 61,860 eastmarks
 - 1 hoisting engine, type FW 13, diameter 1340 mm., 1000 mm. wide, with 70 kw motor
 - 2 pulleys (Seilscheibe) 2500 mm. diameter
 - 2 cages 1600 x 910 mm.
 - 330 m. cable, diameter 18.5 mm.
 - b. Railway equipment, estimated cost 34,000 eastmarks
 - 2 cage unloading platforms
 - 1 electromagnetic spragger with electromagnetic switches
 - 7 foot spraggers
 - 1 chain hoist, type K 12
 - 4 left and right switches
 - 2 loop lines (Bogenweichen)
 - 3 left loop crossings (Links Bog. Ueberg.)
 - 100 m. underground track

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c. Ore grading plant, estimated cost 29,978 eastmarks

- 1 travelling platform (Schiebebuehne)
- 1 geared tipper (Stirnkipper)
- 4 rotary tippers

- 2 chutes

Object 101

2. The Third Administration of the Headquarters of AG Wismut approved in January 1955 an order for the installation of the following equipment at Zeehen 9 and 11 of Object 101:

- * Installation of 6 electric ovens, 2920 x 2370 x 3500 mm. high
- * Installation of 6 switch cables (Schaltpulten) 1300/800 x 2000 mm. high
- 1 rotary tipper
- 3 roller lines (Rollbahnen), each 3100/1090 x 480 mm.
- 4 hoists, each 1100 x 1100 x 1700 mm.
- 1 conveyor screw, 390 mm. diameter 12 m long
- 1 conveyor screw, 390 mm. diameter 9 m. long
- * concentrate bunker (Konzentratbunker)

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4. The total cost of the equipment, excluding items marked with an asterisk, will be 12,835 eastmarks.

Object 6

5. The Third Administration of the Headquarters of AG Wismut approved the following order for mechanical equipment for Object 6 in January 1955:

- 1 conveyor belt, 650 mm. wide, 24.4 m. long
- 1 conveyor belt, 500 mm. wide, 7.9 m. long
- 1 conveyor belt, 500 mm. wide, 19.15 m. long
- 1 conveyor belt, 500 mm. wide, 5.4 m. long

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3 RAS test belts with grading devices (Raspruefband m. Dosiervorrichtung), 800 mm. wide, 4.8 m. long

1 test best without grading device, 800 mm. wide, 4.8 m. long

4 conveyor belts without cages (ohne Fahrgestell) each 5.3 m. long

1 special conveyor belt, 500 mm. wide, 14.2 m. long

6 mechanical spreaders

1 drum sieve, 1000 mm. diameter x 2300 mm.

4 control valves with magnets

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Object 96, Freital

7. The Third Administration of the Headquarters of AG Wismut is considering a plan for the installation of a storage bunker for ore at the ore concentration plant at Object 96 in Dresden-Freital. The mechanical equipment for this enterprise would cost 865,600 eastmarks and the electrical equipment 129,750 eastmarks. The plan has not yet been approved.¹

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1. Comment: [Redacted] the Freital site has become so congested, the primary consideration for any expansion there is whether enough space is available.

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
