Handling of independent travellers and groups

Independent travellers will be issued by Čedok with a/ a hotel ticket, b/ cash in the value of meals /according to category/. The hotel tickets shall include the name of the hotel, the number of the room and the dates for which the room has been reserved, and is to be turned over to the hotel. As far as groups are concerned, the Čedok guide takes care both of the hotel tickets and of payment for meals, according to category. The new system practically removes cases of refunds. In case an independent traveller leaves Czechoslovakia before the expiration of his visa / and of his hotel ticket /, the travel agent who had issued the voucher will be authorised to make the refund. The visitor is expected to have the hotel certify that he has checked out before the validity of his hotel ticket has expired.
