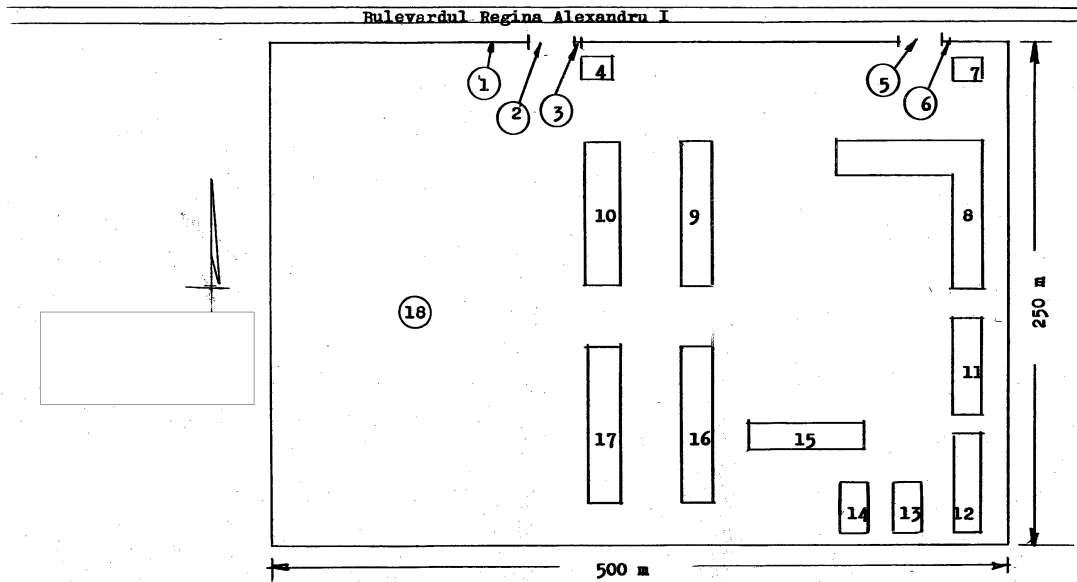

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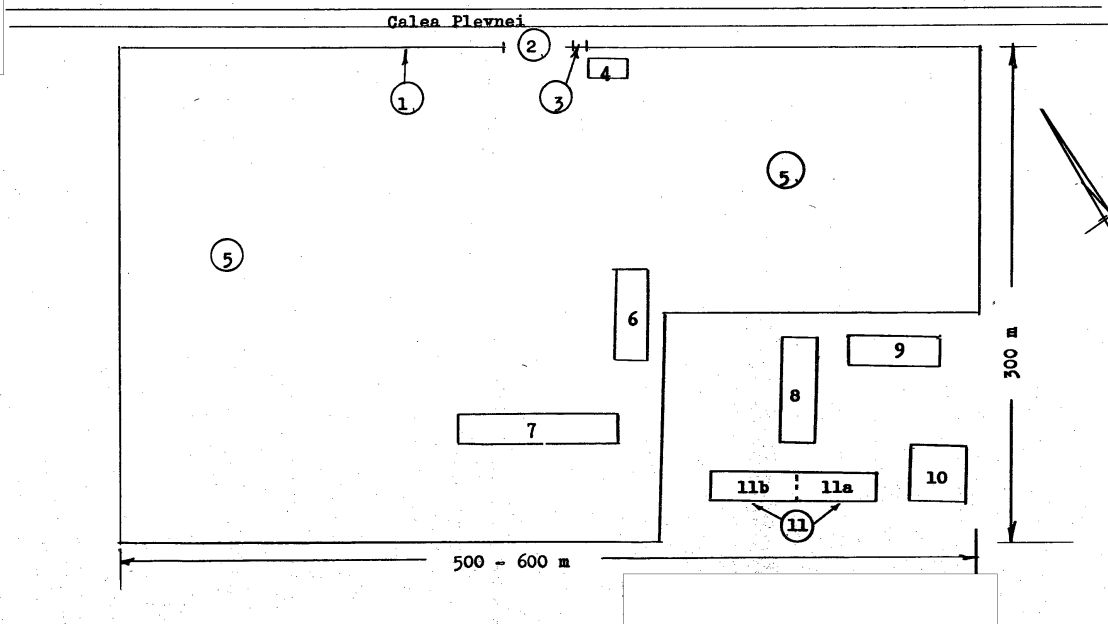

Legend to Annex C

Buildings Occupied by 2d Tank Regt

1. A grey, stucco fence, approximately 3.5 m high.
2. A steel, vehicle gate with its bottom portion made of a solid piece of steel and its top portion made of wire mesh. This was a double gate about 10 m wide and 3 m high, and its doors opened from the center.
3. A steel pedestrian gate with its bottom portion made of a solid piece of steel and its top portion made of wire mesh. It was approximately 1.5 m wide and 3 m high.
4. A white, stucco, one-story guard shack approximately 8 x 8 m, with a red tiled roof. A guard armed with a Czechoslovak ZB rifle was on duty at all times.

5. Other buildings



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6. A white, stucco, unidentified, two-story building approximately 80 x 15 m, with a red tile roof.
7. A white, stucco, unidentified, three-story building approximately 100 to 120 x 20 m, with a red tile gable roof.

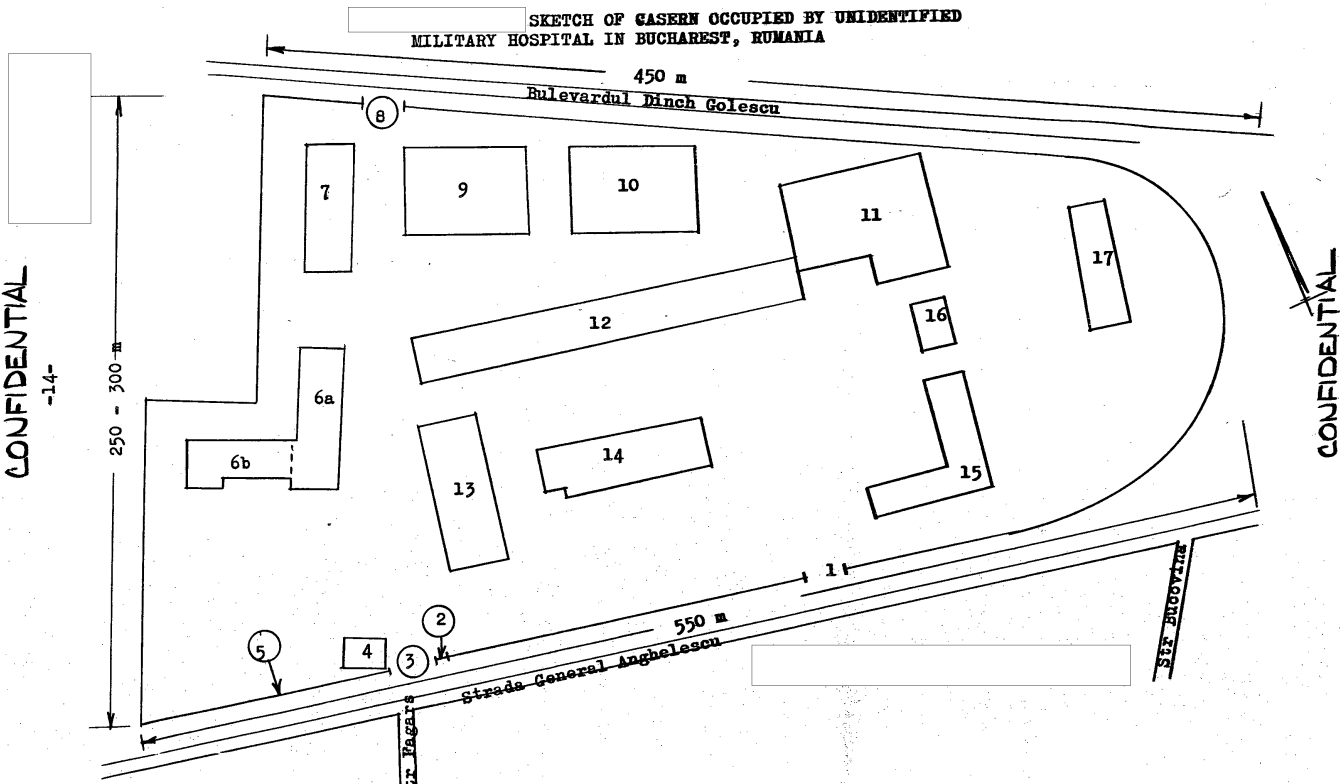

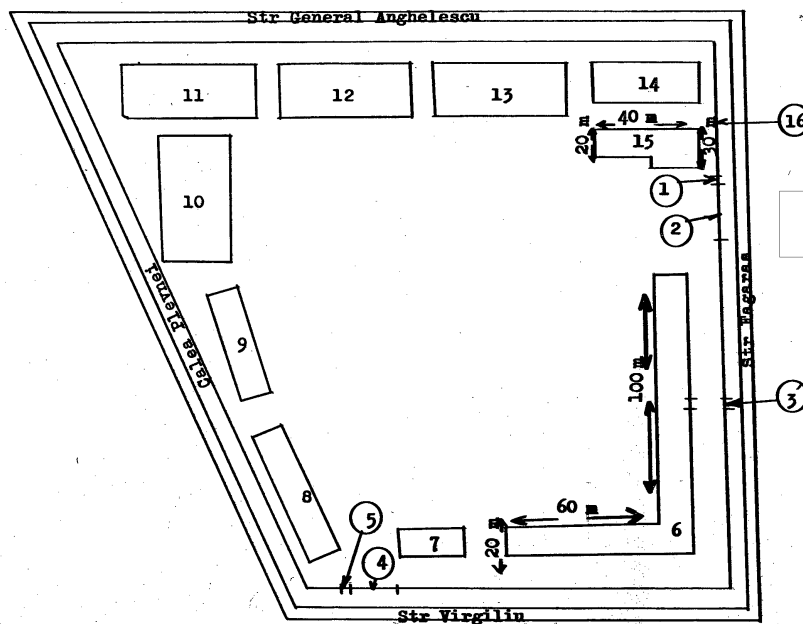


1. Green vehicle gate 8 m wide and 2.5 m high, constructed of iron poles. A guard armed with a Czechoslovak ZB rifle was on duty 24 hours.
2. This pedestrian gate was approximately 1.5 m high and 2.5 m wide, constructed of iron poles.
3. Same as 1. The guard on duty was also responsible for the adjacent pedestrian gate (item 2.)
4. A one-story guard shack, approximately 10 x 10 m, of white stucco with a red tile, gable roof.
5. This fence along Strada General Anghelescu had a cement base approximately 80 cm high and iron pickets approximately 2 m high. The remainder of the fence was grey stucco and approximately 3 m high.
6. An L-shaped, three-story building of white stucco with a red tile gable roof. The northern wing was approximately 50 x 20 m and the western wing was approximately 50 x 15 m.
- 6a. Headquarters and administrative offices.
- 6b. Unidentified medical school.
7. A two-story EM barracks approximately 60 x 15 m, of white stucco with a red tile, gable roof.
8. Vehicle gate approximately 10 m wide and 3 m high. Same as 1. This gate was permanently closed.
9. Unidentified wards in a three-story building approximately 45 x 40 m, of white stucco with a red tile, gable roof.
10. Same as 9.
11. Washrooms, laundry, supply room, and warehouse in a two-story building approximately 60 x 45 m, of white stucco with a red tile gable roof.
12. Unidentified wards in a three-story building approximately 150 x 20 m, of white stucco with a red tile gable roof.
13. A two-story building approximately 40 x 20 m, of white stucco with a red tile, gable roof. There was a kitchen on the first floor. No further information.
14. Out-patients' clinic and laboratory in a three-story building approximately 60 x 20 m, of white stucco with a red tile gable roof.
15. Unidentified wards in a two-story L-shaped building with its northern wing 45 x 15 m and its western wing 35 m x 15 m, of white stucco with a red tile, gable roof.
16. Canteen (PX) was in a one-story building approximately 20 x 15 m, of white stucco with a red tile, gable roof.
17. A one-story, old, wooden warehouse approximately 60 x 20 x 6 m with black tarpaper, gable roof.

1. Green pedestrian gate approximately 1.5 m wide and 2 m high, with a steel frame and wire mesh on the upper half and a solid piece of steel on the lower half of the door.
2. Vehicle gate, approximately 8 x 2 m, same as 1.

5. Same as 1. A guard armed with a Soviet PPSH SMG was on duty 24 hours at gates 1,3, and 5.

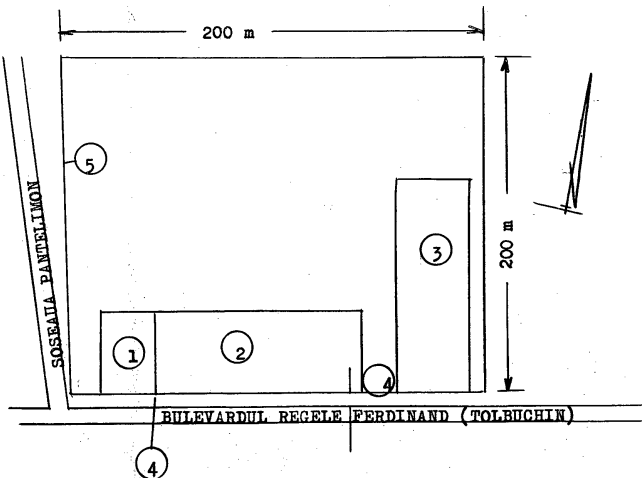

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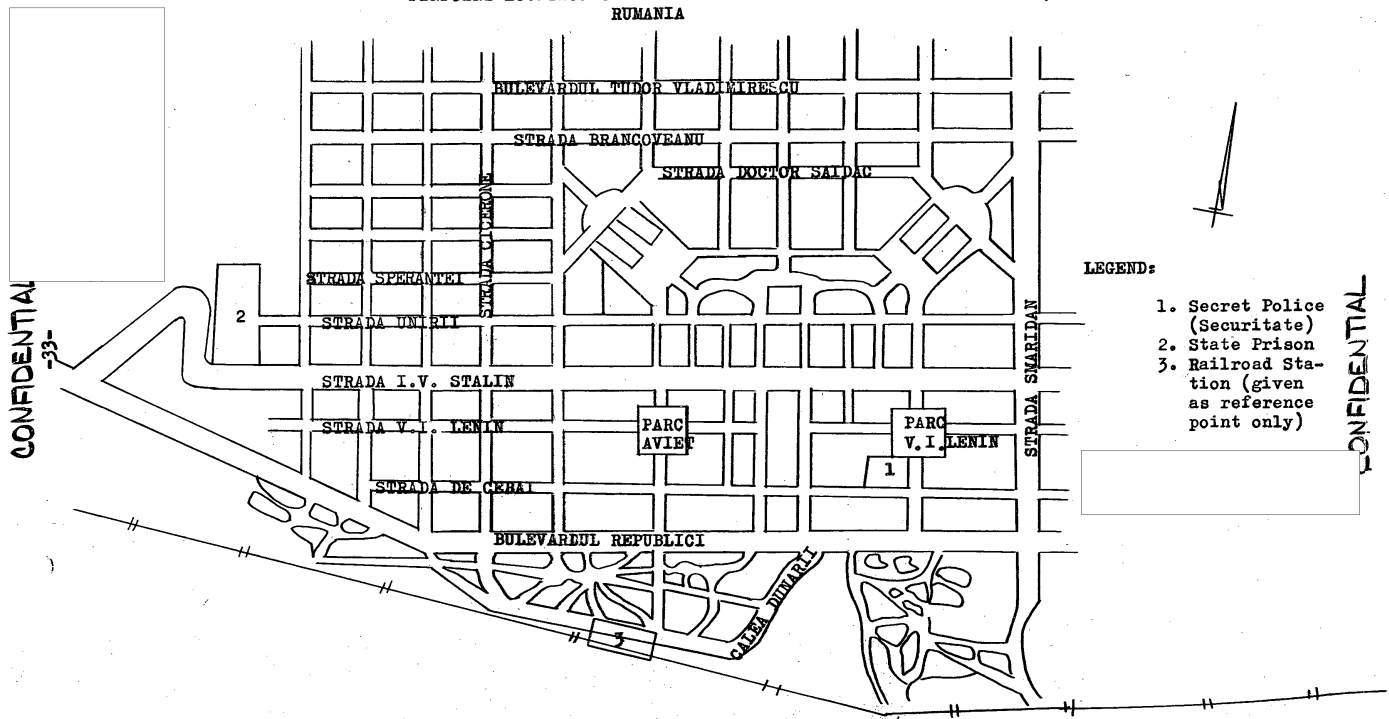

SKETCH OF CASERN OCCUPIED BY THE SECURITY POLICE (SECURITATE) IN TURNU-SEVERIN, ROMANIA

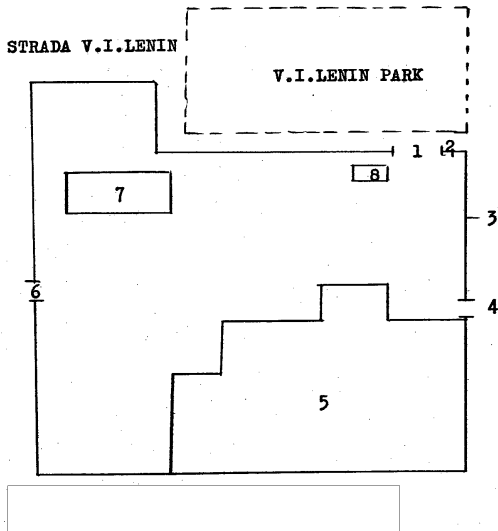
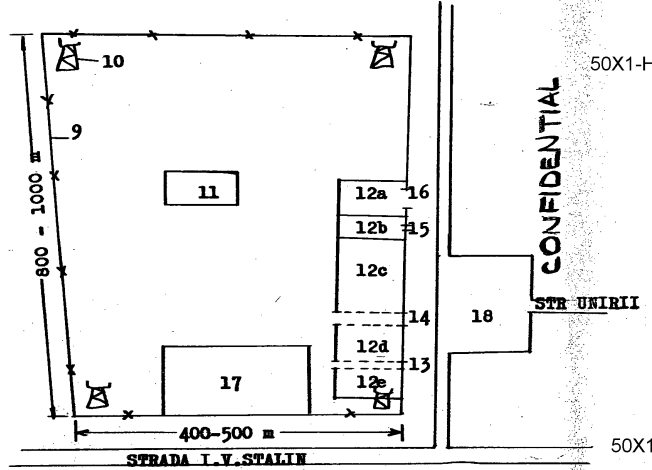

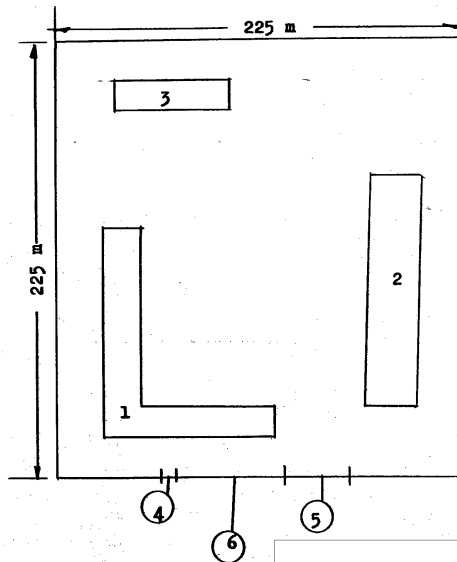

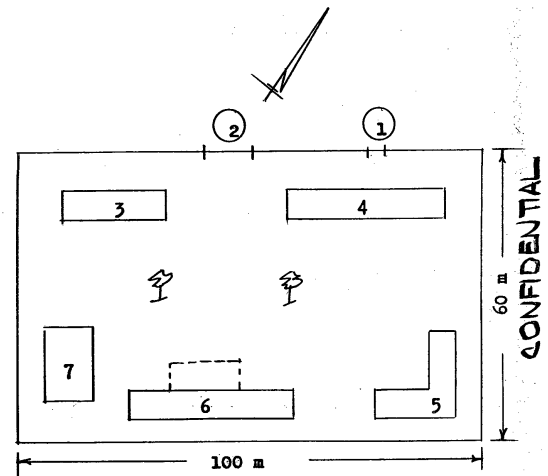

SKETCH OF LOCATION OF UNIDENTIFIED BORDER GUARD BATTALION IN GOGOS, RUMANIA

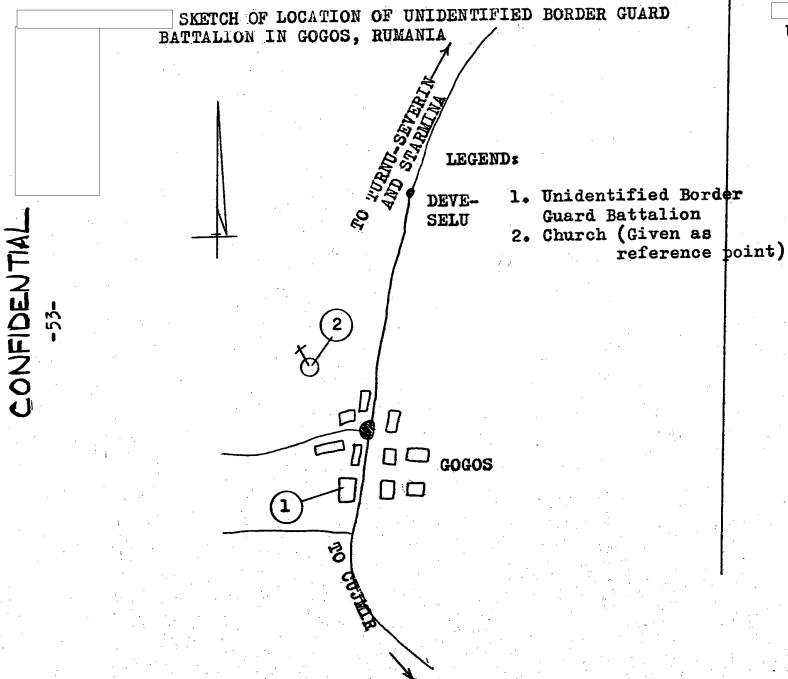
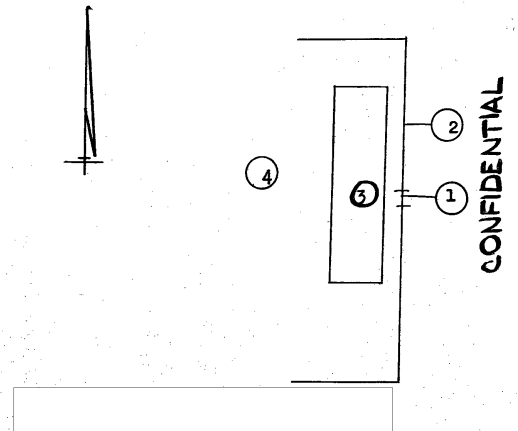

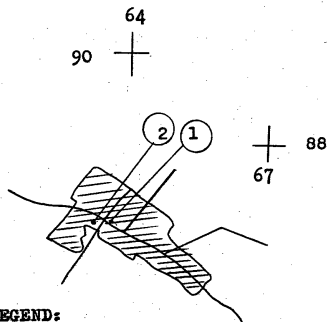

PINPOINT LOCATION OF UNIDENTIFIED BORDER GUARD BATTALION IN CETATE, RUMANIA



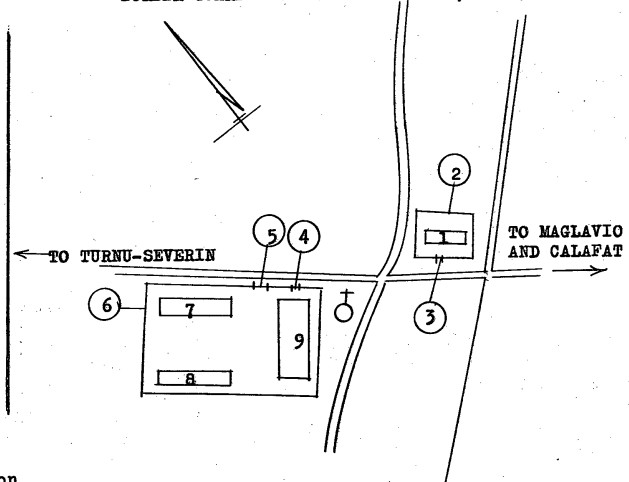

PINPOINT LOCATION OF 7TH BORDER GUARD REGIMENT IN BALA MARE, RUMANIA

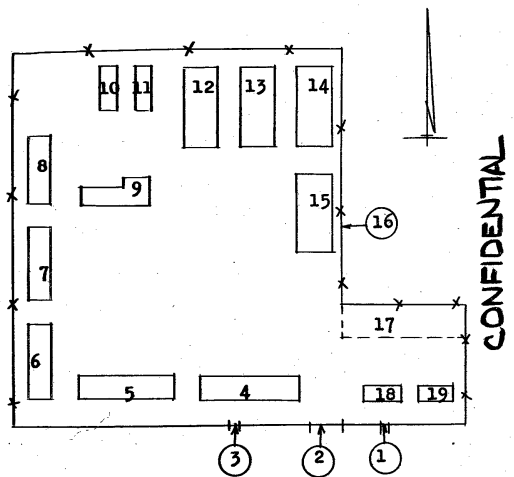

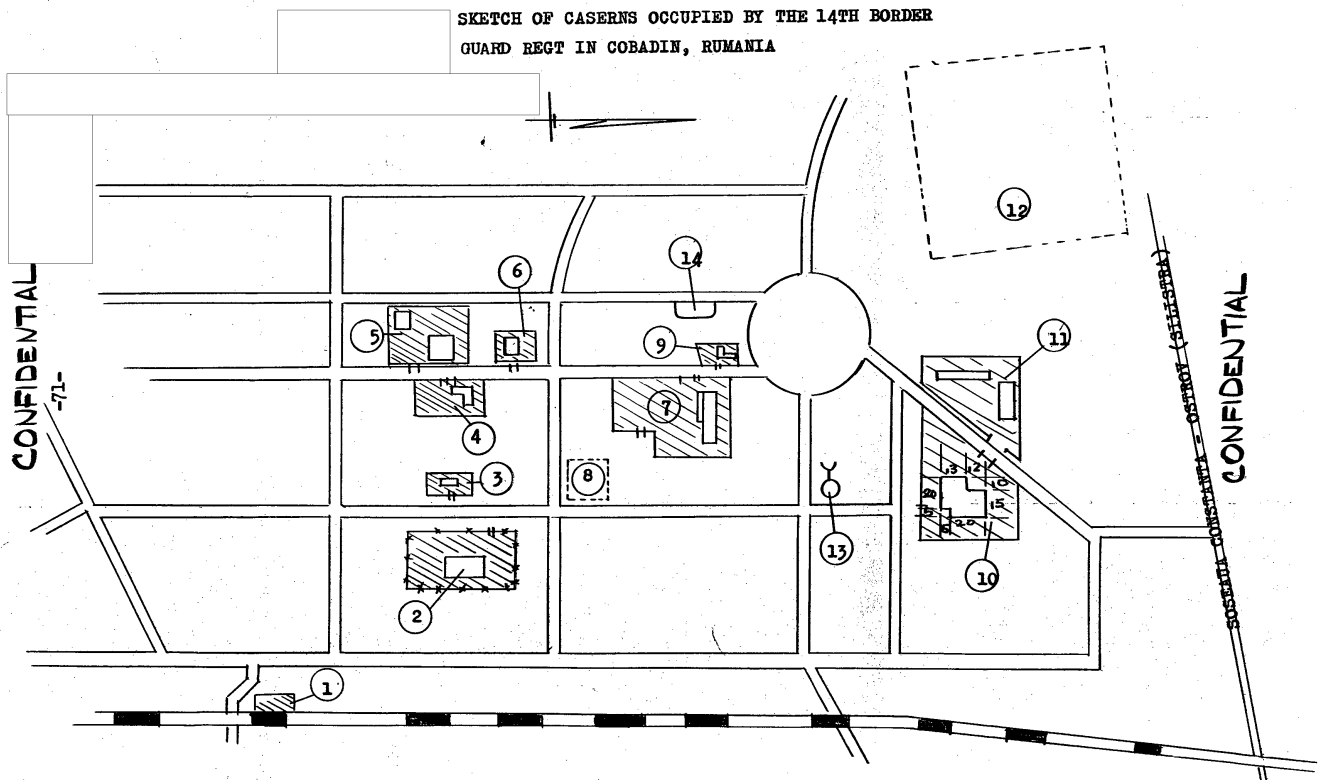
**PINPOINT LOCATION OF 14TH BORDER GUARD REGIMENT IN COBADIN,

MILITARY PRISON IN TARGU-JIU, RUMANIA**

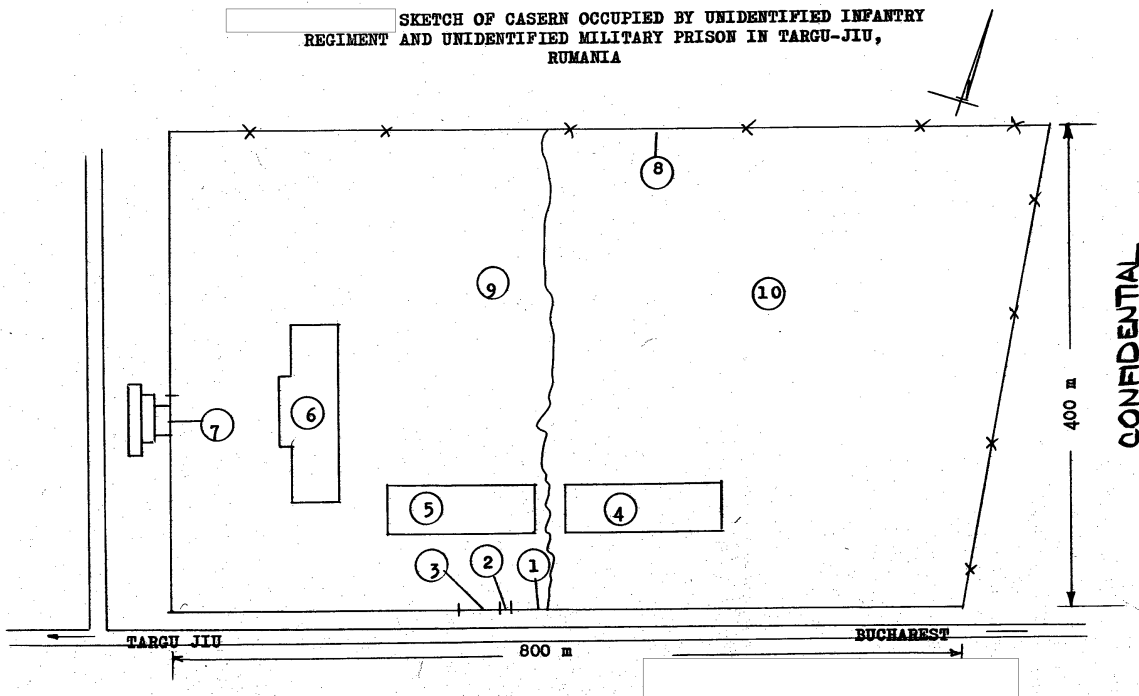

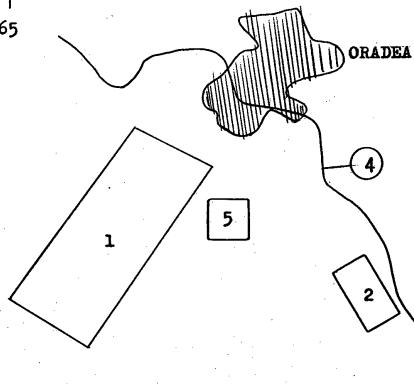

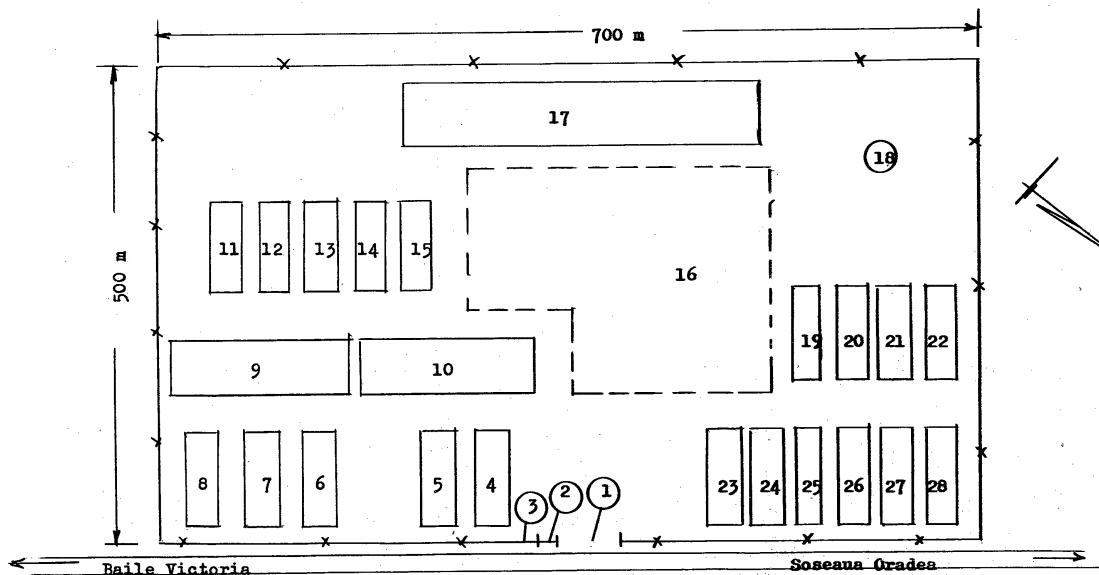

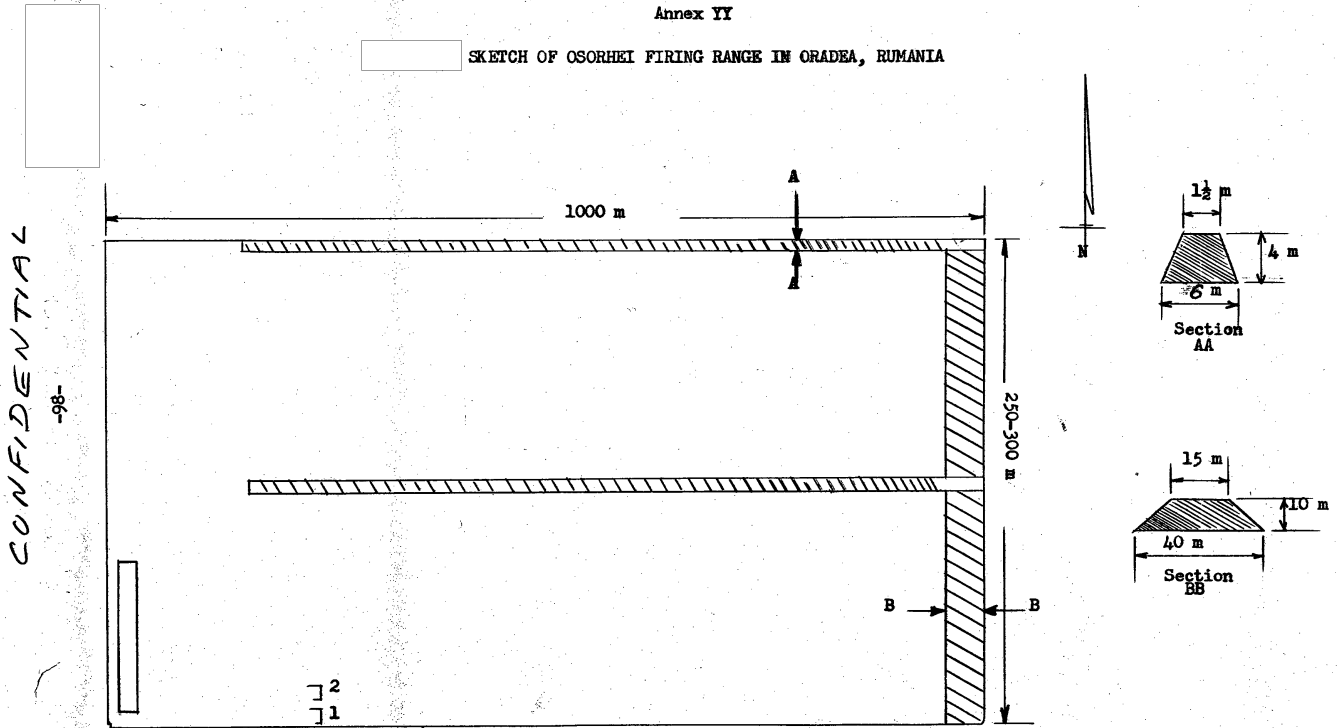

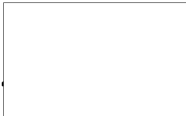

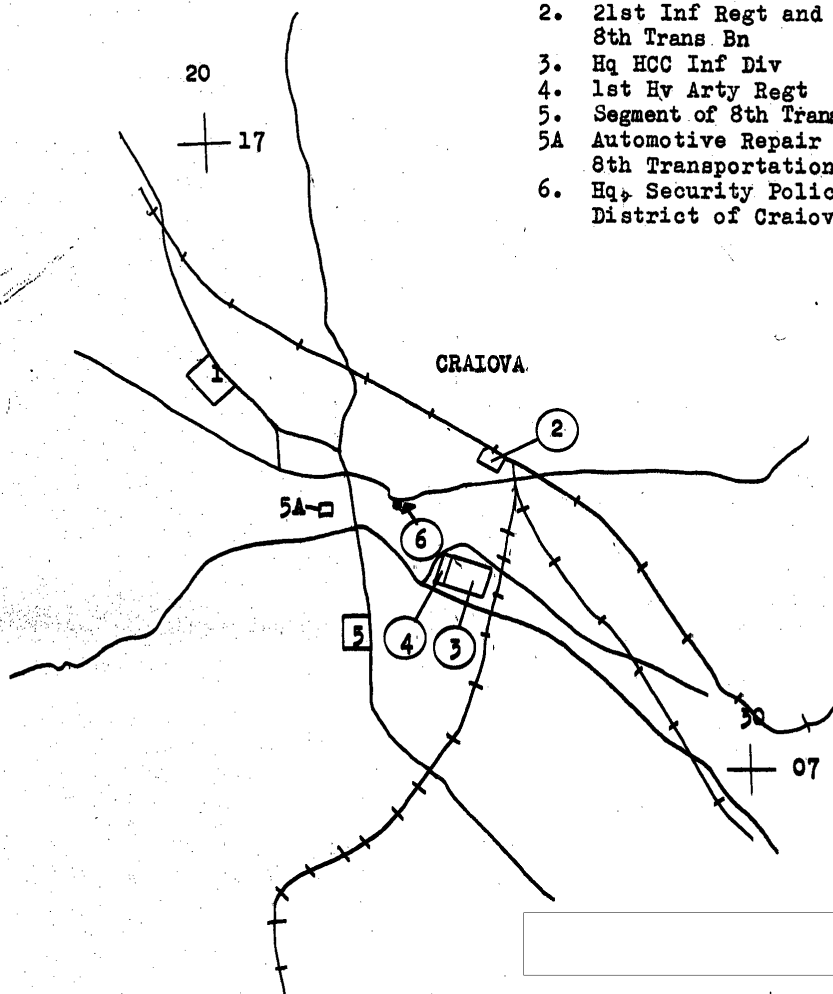
**PINPOINT LOCATIONS OF MILITARY INSTALLATIONS IN CRAIOVA,

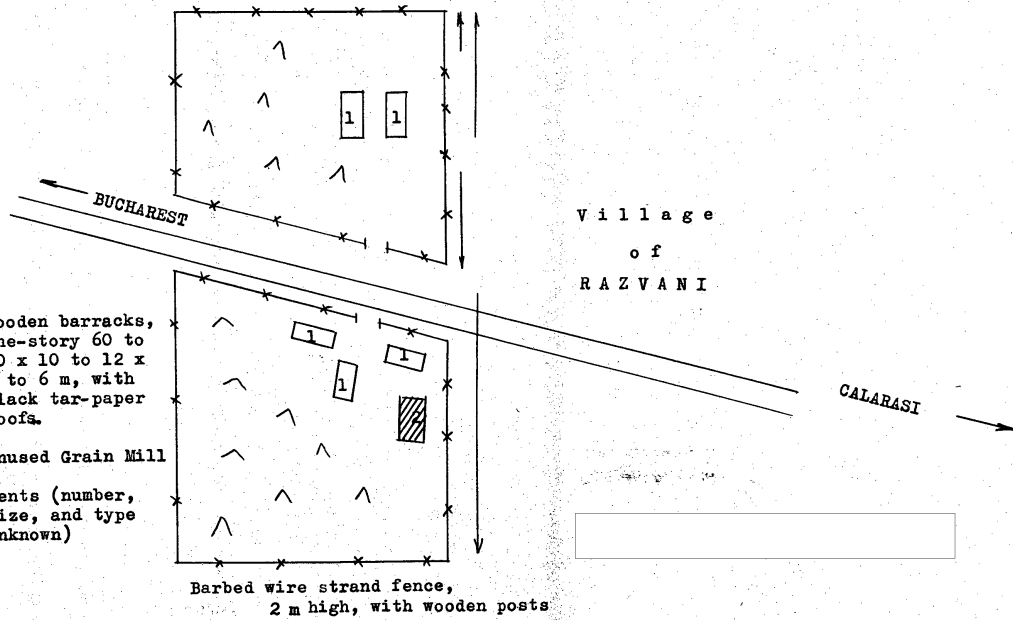
