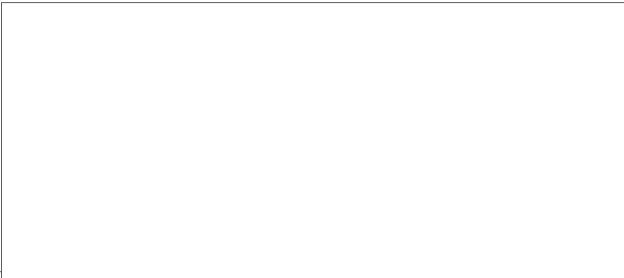

**Description: Slanting stem, length about 100 metres, high forecastle, and long straight stern. Many erections on the deck. The name was placed on the stem with gold letters on a blue plate. Could apparently be screwed off. The ship remained anchored on the roads for a while.**
2. **A green buoy, which does not belong to the official marks, was placed outside Warnemünde.  this buoy marked off some "underwater tackle."** 25X1
