1. Following are observations made of Tolbukhin Airfield on 15 December 1956. The observations were made under unfavorable conditions and only part of the installation was seen:
 - a. The airfield is 3 to 4 kilometers north of the city of Tolbukhin, located in the angle formed by the roads leading to Silistra and General Toshevo;
 - b. The cement runway is approximately 2,500 meters long and seems to run east-west;
 - c. Only one hangar with a glass dome in the eastern part of the field was definitely identified. There were other buildings seen but their use could not be determined;
 - d. An entrance to the field was located on the southeast side; and
 - e. Only two planes were positively identified, both BUTCHERS bearing Bulgarian insignia.

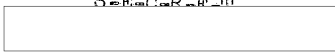
