- This compares with 30 Fagots in May 1956 and 24 Fagots in June 1956.
- In May 1957 about 60 Beast aircraft were observed at the Brno-Slatina 3. airfield.
- On 19 May 1956 an observation was made of the Brno-Slatina airfield during which the 4. following were noted:
 - A battery of DCA with four 85 mm. guns situated at location 33 U XQ 315 495 in the triangle formed by the Brno-Olomouc and the Brno-Holubice-Uherske Hradiste roads.
 - Two machines on a platform, placed under a camouflage net. Their ъ. use was unknown, but perhaps had something to do with firing radar.
- On 12 June 1956 seven Beast aircraft were observed at the Brno-Slatinalairfield 5. but others undoubtedly were there, concealed in the hangers.
