Subject: Albania - Soviet military equipment.

25X1

There are fragmentary reports of the sending of Soviet technical material to Albania.

It is known that this material is arriving continuously, but there are no details concerning it.

25X1

During the past months of Feb and March there arrived in Albania, aeross Yugoslavia, various heavy material. There were observed some military convoys, each composed of about 30 motor vehicles transporting material contained in large boxes, the contents of which one has not yet been able to ascertain.

The greater part of the above materiel was send to blasan, following the route: Costivar - Debar - Elbasan.

Two or three convoys, however, moved along the following route: Gostivar - Debar - Struga - Koritsa, also carrying large boxes containing heavy materials. It was also reported on this occasion that the convoys were transporting machines for the new assumition factory, now under construction in the neighborhood of the aforementioned city.

Subject: Albania - 5th Rifle Division - Argirocastro

The headquarters of the Division in are set up in a palatial residence of the city of Argirocastro.

The commander is a major general whose name is not known. At these headquarters there are always observed some Soviet officers, the highest make rank of which is a colonel.

In the barracks located on the outskirts of the city there are logged the units of the pivision, namely:

- a battalion of automatic weapons,
- a company of engineers,
- a mountain battery,
- a battery of heavy mortars,
- an antia reraft battery,
- a platoon of transports,
- a medical platoon,
- an antigam platoon,
- a platoon for logistic services.

In addition, the following is also lodged in the barracks:

- 311th Bifle Regiment. Commander: Major Naum Boso. Political Commissar;
Major Mehmet Varesi.

The Regiment is made up of 3 rifle battalions, in addition to regimental units. The 3 battalions are stationed near the regimental headquarters, except in the summer months, during which they are transferred to the military proving grounds, located in a mountainous zone about 25 km from the city.

The other units of the Division are stationed as follows: Rifle regiment: with headquarters at Permeti.

Commander: Lt Col Mehmet Dane.

The aforementioned regiment has its units stationed in the following places:

- one battalion with the headquarters units at Permeti;
- one battalion at Leskovicu;
- one battalion at Policami.

A rifle regiment: with headquarters at Delvino. Commander: an Albinian Major.


The aforementioned m regiment has its regimental units stationed in the following places:

- one battalion and the headquarters units at Delvino;
- one g battalion at Konispoli;
- one g battalion at Santi Quaranta.

51st Artillery Regiment: with headquarters at Argirocastro. Commander: LtCol.
Political Commissar: Captain Rexep Spann.

In addition to headquarters units, the regiment consists of 3 groups of artillery, one of which is a mountain group equipped with Aussian phase pieces of 76 mm. The latter is stationed near the rifle battalion at Delvino. The other 2 groups, one a field artillery group and the other a 105 mm howitzer group, are stationed near the regimental command at Arginocastro.

Note: All the units of the division mf are of rather reduced strength, so that the regiments do not exceed 800 men.

FUEL DEPOTS.

Outside the city of GJROKASTER at about 50 meters from the crossroad TEPELENE - KAVAJE, there and on the road which runs from GJIROKASTER and meets the road TEPELENE + KAVAJE, there is a fuel depot. This is a place about (D K 267-381).

Description.

West of the road KAVAJE ... TEPELENE at about 20 meters distance is the (A) main way to the depot. South_west of this (A) main entrance at about 30 meters distance there is building #1, with dimensions 3X3X3 m, built of stones and coverd with tiles and where the sentrys of the depot are sheltered.

At 4 meters distance north of building #1, there is building #2 with 4X3X3 m. built of stenes, covered with tiles and used as office place of the depot.

Between buildings #1 and 2 is entrance or gate (B) of the depot.

West of building # 2 pertly adjacent to it is building # 3
--

built of stones, covered with tiles and used as warehouse for fuel barrels.

South of building # 3 also partly adjacent and similar to it there is another one used for the same purpode. This is building # 4 east of which is a similar building

5 also used for the same purpose.

Parking Places.

In the space between the road KAVAJE. TERRIBLE and gate (A) there is a parking place (#1) where military vehicles are parked.

Between gate (A) and buildings 1 and 2 there is space (#2) where fuel barrels and rells of barbed wire are stored. Fuel barrels and barbed wire are also stored in the space between buildings 3.4 and 5.
