1. The garrison of the East Germany Army barracks at ZITTAU

had a strength in November 1959 of between 1,000 and 1,200 men, made up of:-

- Anti-aircraft regiment - 1700 (approx.)
- Artillery regiment } - 1300-1500 (approx.)
- Bereitschaftspolizei }

2. Accommodation is restricted owing to considerable overcrowding, as the barracks was originally constructed to hold about 1500 men.

3. A sketch of the installations is at Appendix "A". The figures on the sketch indicate:-

- 1 - Office of the garrison commander. In the southern wing is the headquarters of the Anti-aircraft regiment, in the northern the headquarters of the Artillery regiment. The telephone exchange is situated in the cellar of the northern wing of the building.
- 2 - Bereitschaftspolizei quarters.
- 3 - Artillery regiment quarters.
- 4 - Anti-aircraft equipment store.
- 5 - Guardroom and cells.
- 6 - Anti-aircraft regiment quarters.
- 7 - Educational building

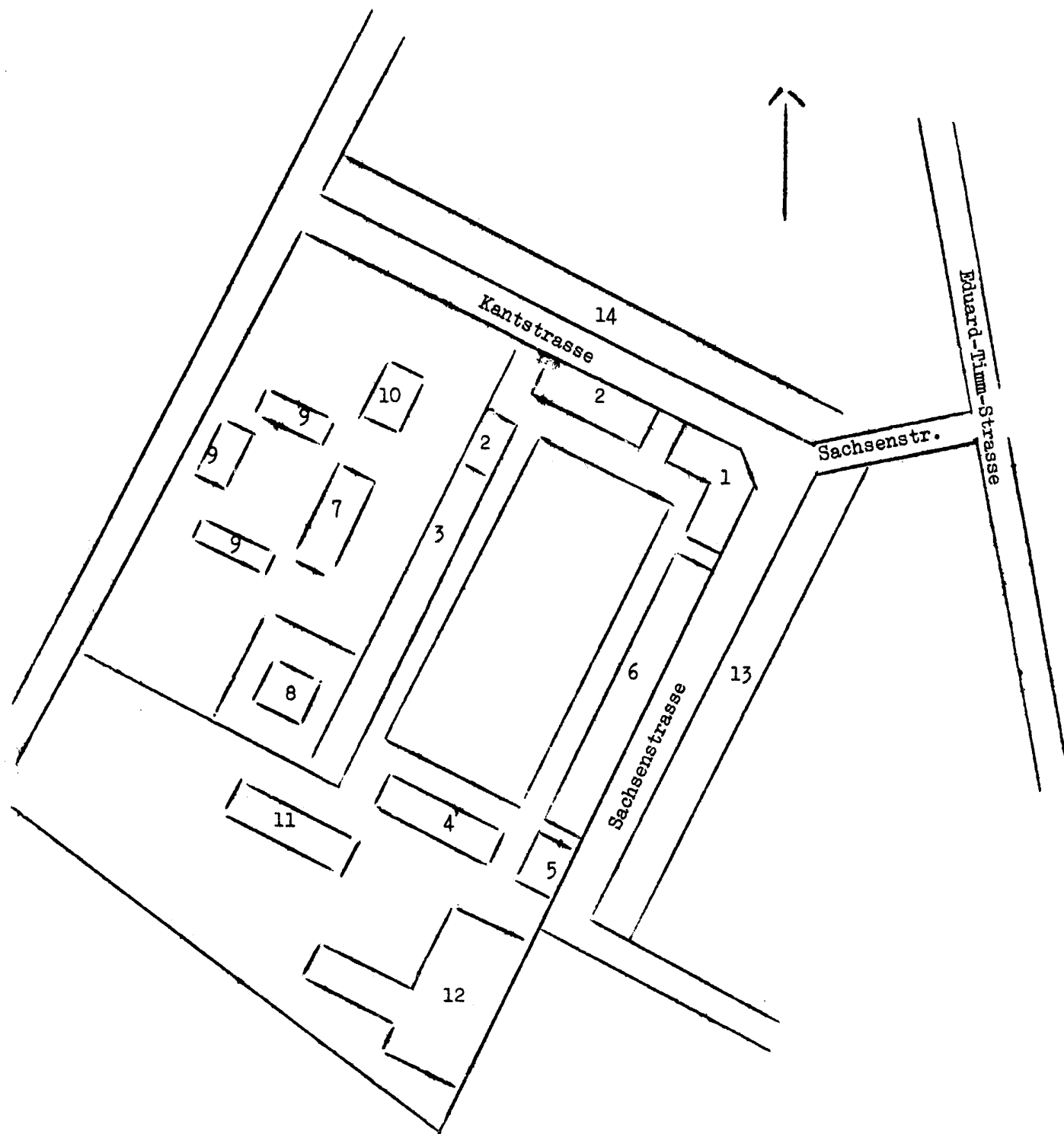
