

- The train left in the KÖNIGSWUSTERHAUSEN direction at 11. 20.00 hours.
- At 04.30 hours on 23rd February, 1961 a further column from BS 3381, REHAGEN, was loaded on to a train at SPERENBERG Station. The loaded train comprised:

12 x G-wagons of Soviet troops 26 x flats, each carrying 1 x armoured TPM and 1 x AT gun 100 mm.

4 x flats each with 1 x ZIS 150 load-carrier

1 x flat with 1 x field kitchen 1 x flat with a workshop vehicle

2 x flats each with 1 x bowser

The loading was supervised by a Soviet Colonel and a 14. Lieutenant-Colonel, both of the Artillery. They were in 50X1-HUM joeps and drove off in the REHAGEN direction after the loading was

15. The train left at about 11.00 hours in the ZOSSEN direction.

#### BS 3381 REHAGEN, equipment sighting.

At 17.00 hours on 18th February 1961, . tracked vehicle was standing in one of the large vehicle shods of BS 3381. The vehicle had the appearance of an AFV chassis, and had a recleat launching superstructure similar to that of the 6-round 280 mm. Rocket launcher on Ya AZ - 214, having six rocket-tubes in two tiers of three each. The superstructure stretched the whole length of the vehicle.
