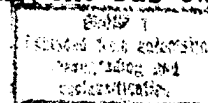
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General:

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[redacted] the population of P'yōngyang-si (YD 3822; N39-01, E125-45) was approximately 700,000. [redacted] NK authorities did not allow the influ- 50X1-HUM of rural population to P'yōngyang-si, except for those officials and workers and dependents who were transferred to posts in the city. The reason that NK regime banned the rural population entry to the city was to check over-inhabitation for housing shortage, keep off political dissidents and to avoid unplanned concentration of population into urban area. When, however, more manpower was needed for construction project in the city, laborers' teams were recruited from rural areas and shipped to the city. The houses in uptown were one story residences, most of them were temporarily built after the Armistice. Supply of water and electricity was made round the clock. Bus was the only transportation facility for P'yōngyang residents. There were nine regular bus lines operating in P'yōngyang - the Loop Line, Yōngje-gyo Line, Sa-dong Line, Changjin-ni Line, West P'yōngyang Railroad Station Line, Kambuk-tong Line, Misan-dong Line, Taet'aryōng Line, and P'yōngch'ōn-ni Line. The starting and terminal stations of these lines are listed in the last part of this report, under the Items from No. 204 to 218. Buses were operated from 0500 hours to 0100 hours the next day; a bus starting from each station in every three or four minutes from 0500 to 2300 hours and in every thirty minutes from 2300 to 0100 hours. The bus fare was 10 chōn for a ride and 60 chōn per month, for a commuter using the bus twice a day.

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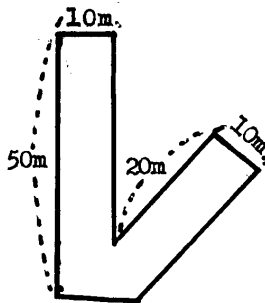


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Explanation to Sketch

- 1) P'yōngyang Agricultural College: A four story block structure with cement-coated walls and a slate roof. [redacted] The college was established at Yongsōng, P'yōngan-namdo [redacted] and moved to P'yōngyang upon completion of the new building. The dimension was as follows (about 15 meters in height):



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- 2) Apartment Houses:

A. Apartment House: Four 4-story block structures with cement-coated walls and slate roofs, measuring about 40 meters long, 8 meters wide and 12 meters high. [redacted] Stores, barbershops and drug-stores occupied the first floors.

B. Apartment House: A 4-story block structure with white lime-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 12 meters high. [redacted]

- 3) Bridge: A reinforced cement bridge, measuring about 60 meters long, 20 meters wide and 2 meters in height from the level of water. It was constructed after the Armistice. Its name might be "Yonghūng-gyo."

- 4) Safehouse, the Liaison Department, KLP Central Committee.

- 5) North Vietnamese Embassy: A two story brick structure with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 20 meters long, 8 meters wide and 7 meters high, built after the Armistice.

- 6) Communist Chinese Embassy: A 3-story structure with cement-coated walls and tile roof, surrounded with fences 2 meters high, with the dimension of about 40 to 50 meters in length, 10 meters in width and 12 meters in height, built after the Armistice. A NKPA soldier was on guard at the main gate.

- 7) Chōnsūng (Victory) Movie House: A brick structure with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 30 meters long, 15 meters wide and 8 meters high, built after the Armistice. Three screenings a day, at 1300 hours, 1800 hours, and 2000 hours respectively, charged 40 chōn for admission. It had a

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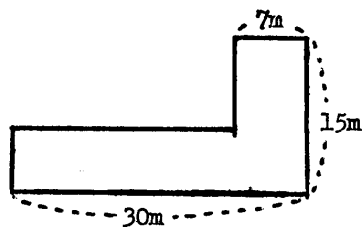
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seating capacity of approximately 500 people.

- 8) Apartment Houses: Four 3-story brick structures with cement-coated walls and slate roofs, built after the Armistice, with the dimension of about 40 meters long, 7 meters wide and 10 meters high.
- 9) P'yŏngnam Buckwheat Vermicelli Restaurant: A 2-story structure with cement-coated walls and a tile roof, measuring about 30 meters long, 10 meters wide and 8 meters high, built after the Armistice.
- 10) Chinese People's Volunteer Forces Memorial Tower (Monument): Erected after the Armistice.
- 11) Apartment Houses: Four 4-story block structures with cement-coated walls and slate roofs, measuring about 40 meters long, 7 meters wide and 12 meters high, built after the Armistice.
- 12) State-run Kirim Restaurant: A 2-story brick structure, built after the Armistice, with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 20 meters long, 10 meters wide and 8 meters high.
- 13) Four-story Apartment House: A block structure [redacted] with a slate 50X1-HUM roof; the first floor was used for stores and the second, third and fourth for residences, measuring about 12 meters high. The ground plan is as follows:

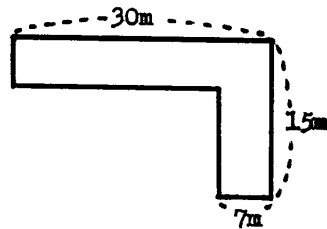


- 14) Three-story Apartment House: A brick structure, built after the Armistice, with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 40 meters long, 7 meters wide and 10 meters high.
- 15) Five-story Apartment House: A block structure [redacted] with a 50X1-HUM slate roof; the first floor was used for stores (clothing and daily necessities), the second, third and fourth floors for residences. The ground plan is as follows (14 meters high):

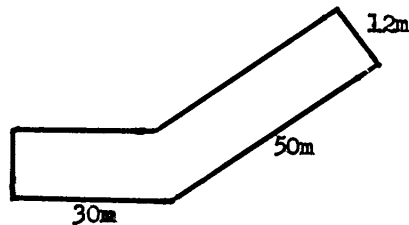
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- 16) Five-story Apartment House: A block structure  with a flat 50X1-HUM roof, measuring about 80 meters long, 7 meters wide and 12 meters high. The first floor was used for stores (clothing and daily necessities), the second, third, fourth and fifth floors for residences.
- 17) West P'yongyang Railroad Station: A single-story wooden structure with a slate roof, measuring about 20 meters long, 8 meters wide and 5 meters high.
- 18) State-run P'yongyang Furniture Factory: Consists of two structures built after the Armistice.
- Office building: A three-story structure with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 30 meters long, 10 meters wide and 10 meters high.
- Factory: A single-story structure with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 80 meters long, 12 meters wide and 6 meters high, producing chests, tables, desks, chairs and other household furnitures.
- 19) KIM Il-sŏng University: Three-story structures built after the Armistice.
- 20) Clinical Hospital: A two-story structure, built after the Armistice, with white limed-walls and a slate roof, measuring about 60 meters long, 6 meters wide and 7 meters high.
- 21) P'yongyang-si People's Committee: A 4-story ~~brick~~ brick structure, built after the Armistice, with cement-coated walls and a slate roof. Its dimensions were as follows (15 meters in height):



- 22) KIP P'yongan-namdo Committee: A 4-story structure, built after the Armistice, with cement-coated walls and a slate roof, measuring about 30 meters long, 15 meters wide and 15 meters high.

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- 23) Four-story Apartment House: A block structure [ ] with a flat roof, measuring about 40 meters long, 7 meters wide and 12 meters high; the first floor used for stores and barber-shop, upper floors for residences.
- 24) Flower-bed in MAO Tse-tung Square;
- 25) State-run Hotel: A four-story block structure, built after the Armistice, with a slate roof, measuring about 40 meters long, 10 meters wide and 12 meters high.
- 26) Three-story Apartment: About 10 brick structures, built after the Armistice, with cement-coated walls and slate roofs, each measuring about 40 meters long, 7 meters wide and 10 meters high. 50X1-HUM
- 27) Eight-story Apartment House: Four block structures [ ] with cement-coated walls and flat roofs, each measuring about 10 meters long, 10 meters wide and 24 meters high.
- 28) Three-story Apartment House: Four brick structures, built after the Armistice, with cement-coated walls and slate roofs, each measuring about 30 meters long, 7 meters wide and 10 meters high; all first floors except one which was used as post office, were used for stores; upper floors for residences. 50X1-HUM
- 29) Four-story Apartment House: Two block structures [ ] with slate roofs, each measuring about 50 meters long, 8 meters wide and 12 meters high; barber-shops and stores occupied all the first floors; upper floors used for residences. 50X1-HUM
- 30) Moranbong Stadium: [ ] The street leading to the stadium from MAO Tse-tung Square was about 50 meters in width. 50X1-HUM
- 31) Ūlmiltae: Historic remains. 50X1-HUM
- 32) Apartment House Area: These apartment houses were [ ] about 30 4-story block structures with slate roofs were now completed and inhabited, each measuring about 80 meters long, 40 to 80 meters wide and 12 meters high.

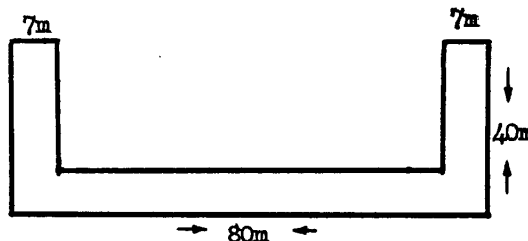

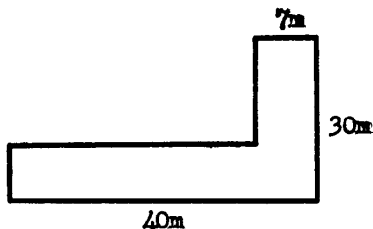


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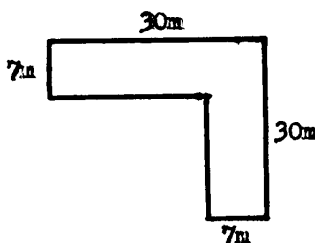

- 47) Five-story Apartment House: A block structure  with a 50X1-HUM flat roof; the first floor used for clothing and grocery stores. The dimensions are as follows:
