1. STRIKE PHOTOGRAPHY OF [redacted]

REVEALS AN ARMY BARRACKS LOCATED 1.8 NM WEST OF DONG HOI. AREA CONTAINS FOUR BARRACKS-TYPE BUILDINGS (THREE OF WHICH ARE BURNING), AND SEVEN SUPPORT BUILDINGS (TWO OF WHICH ARE BURNING). NO CRATERS ARE OBSERVED IN THE AREA.

2. COLLATERAL REPORTS THE BOMB DAMAGE TO BE A RESULT OF THE 7 FEBRUARY AIR STRIKE ON THE DONG HOI AREA BY FORTY-NINE AIRCRAFT FROM THE USS HANCOCK AND USS CORAL SEA.

3. AREA HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY COVERED BY NUMEROUS [redacted] LAZY DAISY, LUCKY DRAGON, AND TROJAN HORSE MISSIONS.
