1. STRIKE PHOTOGRAPHY OF [REDACTED] REVEALS

A BARRACKS AREA LOCATED ON THE NORTHEAST EDGE OF VINH LINH, AND 4.2 NM SOUTHEAST OF CHAP LE. NO APPARENT DAMAGE WAS INFLICTED TO THE BARRACKS AREA; HOWEVER, FOUR DESTROYED BUILDING, FOURTEEN HEAVILY DAMAGED BUILDINGS, SEVERAL BURNING BUILDINGS, AND NUMEROUS BOMB CRATERS ARE OBSERVED ALONG THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF ROUTE 1 IN THE VILLAGE OF VINH LINH (HO XA).

2. [REDACTED] REVEALS THE MILITARY

GARRISON TO CONTAIN EIGHT BARRACKS, SIX STORAGE BUILDINGS, THREE ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, ONE MESSHALL, APPROXIMATELY TWENTY-FIVE MISCELLANEOUS BUILDINGS AND SHEDS, AN ATHLETIC FIELD, AND A SMALL ARMS FIRING RANGE.

3. COLLATERAL REPORTS THE CHAP LE AREA WAS THE OBJECT OF AN AIR STRIKE BY THE SOUTH VIETNAMESE AIR FORCE FLOWN 8 FEBRUARY WITH US AIR SUPPORT.

4. AREA HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY COVERED BY NUMEROUS [REDACTED] LAZY DAISY, LUCKY DRAGON, AND TROJAN HORSE MISSIONS.

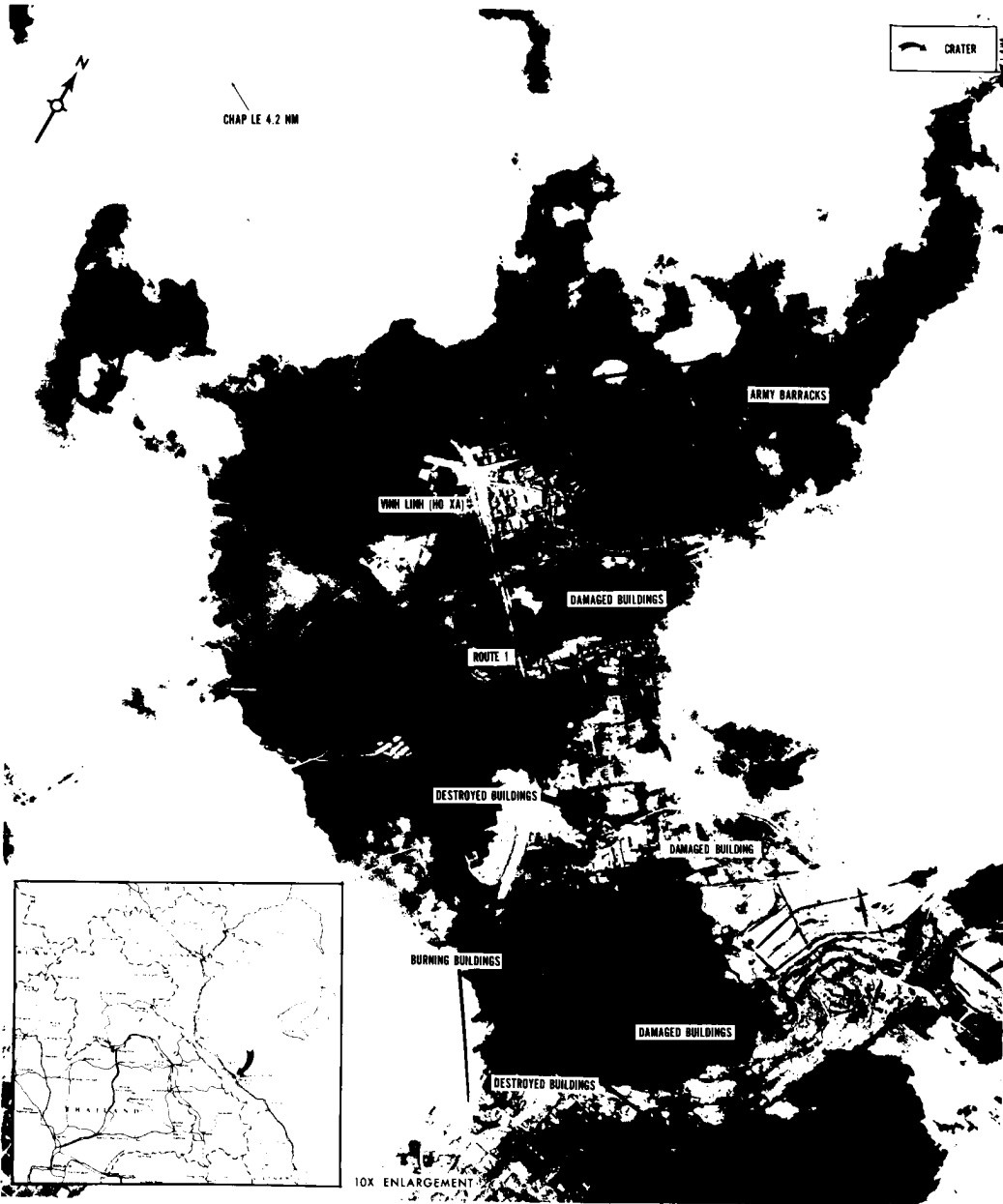
