VINH AIRFIELD, NORTH VIETNAM

1. MISSION BLUE TREE 1002B, 3 APRIL 1965, REVEALS VINH AIRFIELD, LOCATED 3.5 NM NORTH OF VINH, TO CONSIST OF A 6,400 X 190 FT. NNW/SSE SERVICEABLE RUNWAY WITH A 680 FT. OVERRUN TO THE NORTH-NORTHWEST AND A 310 FT. OVERRUN TO THE SOUTH-SOUTHEAST. FACILITIES INCLUDE A PARALLEL LINK TAXIWAY AND A 1,400 X 340 FT. PARKING APRON WEST OF THE RUNWAY. ELEVEN REVETTED HARDSTANDS ARE OBSERVED EAST OF THE SSE END OF THE RUNWAY; THREE REVETTED HARDSTANDS ARE LOCATED ON THE RUNWAY'S WEST SIDE. NO AIRCRAFT ARE OBSERVED.

2. TROJAN HORSE [REDACTED] REVEALS THE RUNWAY TO BE 6,400 X 200 FT., PROBABLE PIERCED STEEL PLANK. THE PARKING APRON IS OBSERVED TO BE OF PIERCED STEEL PLANK/LATERITE CONSTRUCTION. TWENTY-FIVE REVETTED HARDSTANDS (EITHER NEWLY-CONSTRUCTED OR CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION) ARE NOTED. EIGHTEEN OF THESE HARDSTANDS ARE OBSERVED TO HAVE THE SLIT CONFIGURATION FOR EXHAUST VENTS/PERSONNEL EXIT PURPOSES. FACILITIES INCLUDE ONE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, FOUR BARRACKS BUILDINGS, TWO PROBABLE VEHICLE MAINTENANCE BUILDINGS, TWO LARGE STORAGE BUILDINGS, AND AT LEAST FIVE SUPPORT BUILDINGS. NO AIRCRAFT ARE OBSERVED.

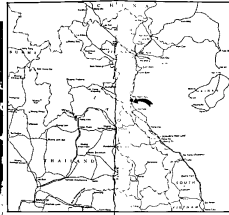
