1. KEP AIRFIELD WAS FIRST OBSERVED IN SEPTEMBER 1959 AND WAS SUBSEQUENTLY COVERED BY TALENT, [REDACTED] LAZY DAISY, BLUE SPRINGS, AND TROJAN HORSE PHOTOGRAPHY.

2. LAZY DAISY [REDACTED] REVEALS A 4,100 X 90 FT. NE/SW SERVICEABLE SOD RUNWAY 1.1 NM WEST OF KEP. FACILITIES INCLUDE 6 WAREHOUSES, 7 SUPPORT BUILDINGS AND A WEATHER STATION. FOURTEEN AIRCRAFT REVETMENTS ARE OBSERVED. AIRCRAFT -- 4 HOUND.

3. TROJAN HORSE [REDACTED] REVEALS A 4,100 X 80 FT. NE/SW UNSERVICEABLE SOD RUNWAY. NEW CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY AT THE AIRFIELD INCLUDES 2 NEW REVETTED HARDSTANDS APPROXIMATELY 85 X 85 FT. IMMEDIATELY EAST OF THE NORTHEAST PORTION OF THE RUNWAY. ONE IS OBSERVED TO HAVE THE SLIT CONFIGURATION FOR EXHAUST VENTS/PERSONNEL EXIT PURPOSES. FOUR OF THE 14 OLD REVETMENTS HAVE UNDERGONE IMPROVEMENT. A PARALLEL SOD TAXIWAY EAST OF THE RUNWAY WITH REVETMENT APPROACHES HAS BEEN CONSTRUCTED. THE NORTHEAST PORTION OF THE RUNWAY OVERRUN IS PRESENTLY UNDERGOING CONSTRUCTION/IMPROVEMENT. FIVE CONSTRUCTION VEHICLES ARE OBSERVED AT THE CONSTRUCTION SITE. HEAVY TRACK ACTIVITY IS OBSERVED ON THE RUNWAY. AIRCRAFT OBSERVED -- 3 HOUND.

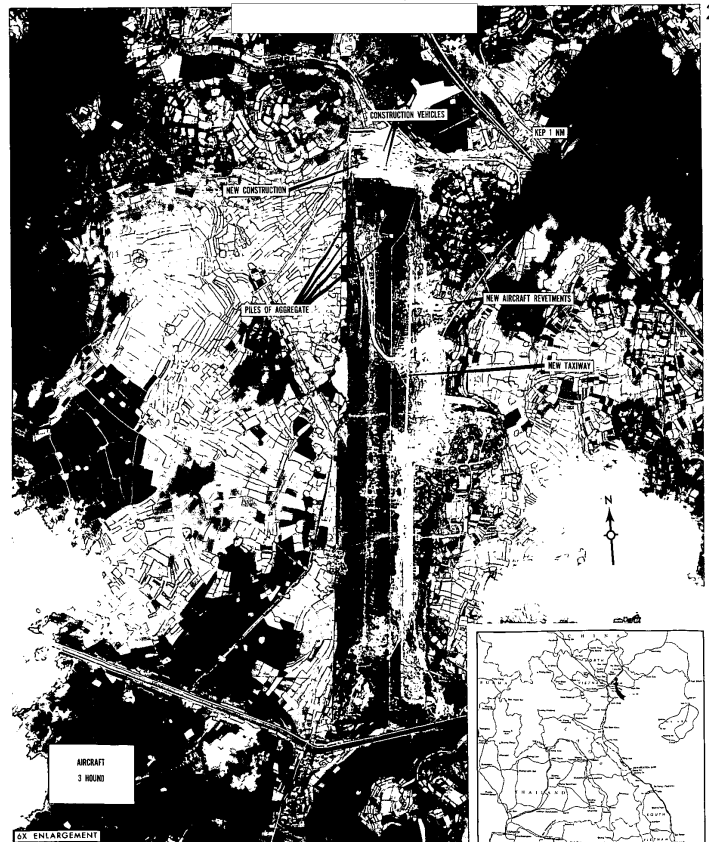
