EIGHT SPAN PROBABLE WOOD DECK-TYPE HIGHWAY BRIDGE APPROXIMATELY 140 FT.  
LONG OVER THE SONG KIEM ICH (RIVER) 0.8 NM EAST-SOUTHEAST OF SAN DINH.

2. POST-STRIKE PHOTOGRAPHY OF UE [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED], REVEALS THAT THE BRIDGE AND BOTH APPROACHES HAVE BEEN COMPLETELY  
DESTROYED.

3. STRIKE DATA REPORTS THAT THE TARGET AREA WAS STRUCK ON 23  
APRIL 1965 BY 25 US NAVY AIRCRAFT SUPPORTED BY 16 US NAVY AIRCRAFT.  
ORDNANCE EXPENDED CONSISTED OF FOURTEEN 1000 LB. GENERAL PURPOSE BOMBS,  
AND FOURTEEN LAU-3A ROCKETS.

4. AREA HAS BEEN COVERED BY PREVIOUS [REDACTED] TROJAN HORSE,  
[REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] MISSIONS.
