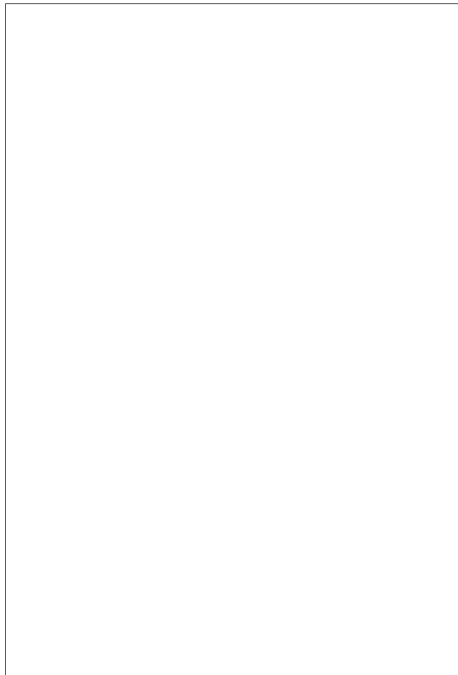

CHOU-SHAN NAVAL BASE AND SHIPYARD

1. CHOU-SHAN NAVAL BASE OCCUPIED THE SITE OF AN INACTIVE SEAPLANE STATION WITH PORTIONS OF THE ABANDONED CHOU-SHAN AIRFIELD USED FOR STORAGE. THE NAVAL BASE SERVES AS ONE OF THE EIGHT NAVAL BASES AND STATIONS SUBORDINATE TO THE EAST SEA FLEET HEADQUARTERS AT SHANG-HAI.
2. COMBAT VESSELS HAVE BEEN OBSERVED ON THE FOLLOWING MISSIONS:

3. FACILITIES AT THE NAVAL BASE INCLUDE ONE LARGE C-SHAPED AND 14 OTHER BARRACKS, ONE T-SHAPED ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, 2 OTHER ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, 2 MESS HALLS, AND 11 STORAGE/SUPPORT

BUILDINGS. AN OLD SEAPLANE BASE APRON IS USED AS AN OPEN STORAGE AREA. THERE ARE 3 T-HEAD PIERS ADJACENT TO THE OPEN STORAGE AREA. THE SHIPYARD, LOCATED 1.4 NM WNW OF THE NAVAL BASE, CONTAINS 4 END-LAUNCHING SHIPBUILDING WAYS, ONE MARINE RAILWAY, ONE T-HEAD PIER, A SMALL FINGER PIER, 20 LARGE SHOPS AND WAREHOUSES, 17 BARRACKS, ONE MULTISTORY BUILDING, AND ONE MESS HALL. THERE ARE 10 OTHER T-HEAD PIERS, 4 SMALL FINGER PIERS, AND 2 MARINE LAUNCHES IN THE PORT AREA.

4. [REDACTED] REVEALS 2 RIGA CLASS DE; 4 T-43 CLASS MSF; 1 KRONSHADT CLASS PC; 1 KAIBOKAN II CLASS PF; 2 PROB PC; 4 YP AND NUMEROUS SMALL CRAFT.
5. INCLUDED IN THE CHINESE COMMUNIST NAVAL FORCE ARE 4 RIGA CLASS DE'S, 14 T-43 CLASS MSF'S, 24 KRONSHADT CLASS PC'S, AND 4 KAIBOKAN CLASS PF'S. THE 4 RIGA CLASS DE'S WERE PRODUCED AT THE HU-TUNG SHIPYARD IN SHANG-HAI AND ARE ASSIGNED TO THE EAST SEA FLEET. TWO OF THE 14 T-43 CLASS MSF'S WERE OBTAINED FROM THE USSR IN 1954, AND THE OTHER 12 WERE PRODUCED IN CHINESE SHIPYARDS. SIX OF THE 24 KRONSHADT CLASS PC'S WERE ACQUIRED FROM THE USSR IN 1955, WITH THE OTHER 18 BEING PRODUCED IN CHINESE SHIPYARDS. THE 4 KAIBOKAN CLASS PF'S WERE INHERITED FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA WHEN IT EVACUATED MAINLAND CHINA IN 1949.

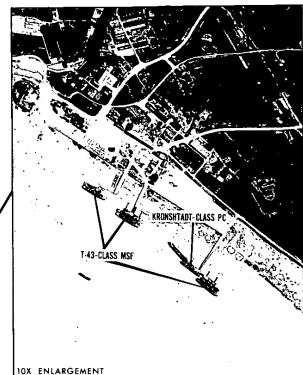

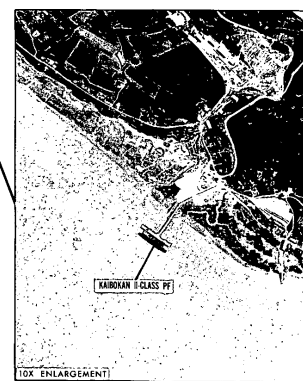

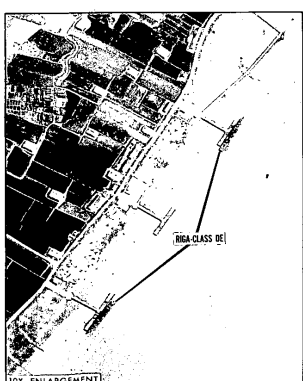
