TU DUNG. TWO PONTOON BRIDGE SECTIONS ARE BEING CONSTRUCTED TWO HUNDRED
YARDS NORTH OF THE DESTROYED BRIDGE, AND CONSTRUCTION PERSONNEL ARE OBSERVED ATTACHING FLOORING TO ONE OF THESE SECTIONS. EIGHT POSSIBLE PONTOON
FLOAT SECTIONS ARE LOCATED NEAR THE CONSTRUCTION SITE.

UE 731/1, 18 JANUARY 1966, REVEALS A BY-PASS UNDER CONSTRUCTION JUST SOUTH OF THE DESTROYED BAI XAI HIGHWAY BRIDGE SOUTHEAST OVER THE NAM XAN (RIVER) ON ROUTE 7. GROUND SCARRING INDICATES THE USE OF EARTH MOVING EQUIPMENT TO EXTEND THE BY-PASS ROAD FROM BOTH BANKS OF THE NAM XAN. THE CENTER OF THE RIVER REMAINS OPEN AT THIS TIME.
