CU XA CONG CHUC IS A WELL-ESTABLISHED FACILITY WITH NUMEROUS BARRACKS, SUPPORT BUILDINGS, MISCELLANEOUS BUILDINGS, AND AN AIRSTRIP.

4. **EVALUATION:**

THE INTERPRETABILITY OF THE BLACK AND WHITE AS WELL AS THE COLOR PHOTOGRAPHY OVER THIS INSTALLATION IS RATED AS GOOD. THE COLOR TONE IS ALSO GOOD. THE GREATEST DIFFERENCE IN INTERPRETATION CONCERNS VEHICLE COUNT (79 OBSERVED ON BLACK AND WHITE; 33 ON COLOR FILM). THE RESOLUTION OF THE COLOR FILM WAS NOT SUFFICIENT TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN
