On 1 February 1978 the Office of General Counsel (OGC) notified the Office of Training (OTR) that OGC has withdrawn its concurrence in the proposed revision of the Counsel STATINTL The reason cited is that the new Executive Order 12036 prohibits undisclosed participation in domestic organizations by employees of agencies within the

2. OTR recognizes that the OGC interpretation could seriously restrict or impair the Agency's ability to secure external training for personnel under cover. Accordingly, we plan to request clarification from the OGC on the following points:

advising "appropriate officials" of their CIA affiliation. Attached are copies of the memorandum from OGC and extracts

- a. Is training of a student at an academic institution a "contract or arrangement for the provision of goods or services?"
- b. Is the Agency planning to request the Attorney General to exempt training from these restrictions for individuals under cover?
