There was no new construction in the harbor area and all of the buildings and equipment appeared in poor condition and in need of repair. no Naval installations in the Westerplatte Basin area.

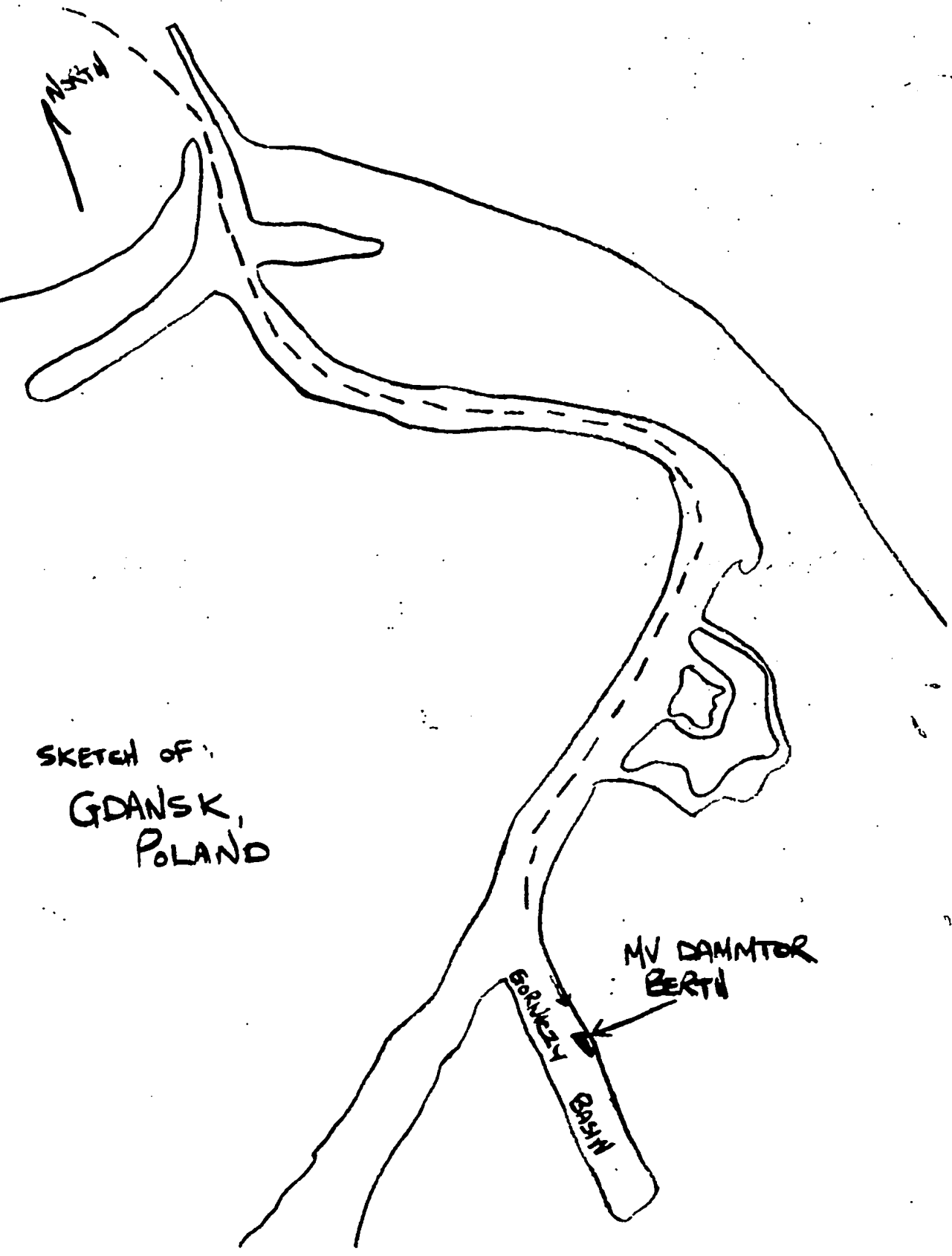
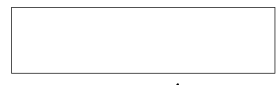
