1. Reference (b) postpones informal progress report for subject study until 1 June 1947; however, this Branch is ready to proceed immediately with the following steps:

- a. Review of films in nine showings in accordance with schedule attached as Tab A.
- b. Invite representative of ORE in accordance with memorandum for your signature attached as Tab B.
- c. Extend an oral invitation to the Requirements Branch to attend showing for the purpose of determining control and other requirement matters.
- d. Through the means of these showings determine dissemination to IAB agencies. As films are reviewed and if questions arise as the need for these films by IAB agencies, representatives of these agencies will be invited to attend additional showings.
- e. On the basis of la, b, c, d above prepare necessary dissemination orders in accordance with reference a.

2. Approval for use of the Administration Building for the showing of subject films (Tab A) has been given by Executive Secretary for OCD. STAT

3. Documents Branch, OO will provide qualified Japanese language personnel to assist in the preparation of written summaries of each film for use in making decisions as to the intelligence value and ultimate disposition of films.


