SUBJ: Expenditure and Allotment Reports - SPG

- 1. Attached hereto are reports of expenditures and allotments for the fiscal years 1948 and 1949.
- 2. It will be noted that there is a variation in the form of report between the two fiscal years. This is due to the fact that during 1948 the standard U. S. government objective classifications were used in recording all expenses of projects, but during 1949 a new classification of only three breakdowns represented by A. B. and C was employed in recording project expenses.
- 5. To assist you in better understanding and analyzing these reports, the following information in this connection is submitted:
 - (a) The expense breakdowns by Ol through O9 represent objective classifications as follows:
 - Ol Salary and allowance of J. S. staff employees.
 - Of Travel expenses, per diem, and normal automotive maintenamen.
 - OS Transportation of things, including shipments of personal and household effects, equipment or supplies.
 - O4 Gormunications, including cable costs to and from the field and legal telephone or wire facilities.
 - OS Rents and utilities, including rent of offices, post office boxes, equipment, garages, and use of public utilities.
 - 06 Printing and binding.
 - OT Other contractual services, Commetics, entertainment, newspagers, unintenance and repairs to offices and equipment, etc.
 - 08 Arpendable supplies.
 - 09 Non-expendable equipment.
 - (b) The elassifications of expense for projects as shown on the 1949 schedule are as follows:

(e) Unaccounted for outstanding advances are added to the expenses to determine the total charge to the corresponding alletment, since all disbursements of funds must necessarily be chargeable to an alletment. Also it is anticipated that advances will become

expenses when accounted for and in order to properly maintain a control of the expenses in accordance with the budget limitations, this practice was adopted.

(4) The alletment to the represents the annual alletment designated for home office by the Budget Office. The alletment to projects plus the alletment figure designated as "Unalletted to Specific Projects" represents the annual alletment to foreign by the Budget Office.
