The following procedures should be used in reviewing the Select Committee's Draft Reports:

1. The documents are to be examined at Committee offices.

2. A list of comments concerning revelation of sources and methods (raising problems such as disclosure of identity of informants or undercover agents or officers, impact on current operations, etc.) should be kept, including:

- (a) Page and paragraph of the passage in question;
- (b) Reason for the objection in the present language;
- (c) Suggested re-write.

The Committee will type these comments and provide the Agency with a copy for further discussions.

3. Any editorial comments which involve a question as to the accuracy of statements of fact or analysis in the report should be listed separately from the sources and methods comments.
