1. Between 1 and 31 Dec 53, the following cargoes were loaded for Satellite countries of the USSR:

- a. Szeged (Hungarian registry), 25,038 kilograms woolen rags for Burgas.
- b. Samoland (Swedish registry), 50,000 kilos, woolen rags for Burgas.
- c. Budapest (Hungarian registry), 7,142 kilograms tobacco, 35,270 kilograms of nuts (presumably hazel nuts) for Hungary. 25X1

2. Between the same dates, the following cargoes were loaded Satellite countries:

- a. Budapest (Hungarian registry), 188,766 kilograms of valonia (tanning material) for Burgas. 25X1
- b. Mangalia (Rumanian registry), 130,000 kilograms of cotton for Constanța.

3. Between the same dates, the following cargoes were loaded

- a. Gent (Turkish registry), 1,670,000 kilograms of rice, lentils, and beans for Constanța.
- b. Debrecen (Hungarian registry), 500,000 kilograms of beans and 300,000 kilograms of lentils for Constanța.
- c. Debrina (Bulgarian registry), 350,000 kilograms of beans for the port of Varna (Staline).
