1. The manufacture of a 5 KW short wave sender for the Seepolizei is scheduled. It is to be installed at Cape Arkona.
2. The development and construction of the 50 KW short wave sender for Leipzig has cost 55,000 marks, of which the control stage alone represented 40,000 marks.
3. Six automatic see emergency sender-receivers have been delivered to Poland.
4. Deliveries of nickel-iron wire were received on 2 Mar 54. The wire came from Poland.
