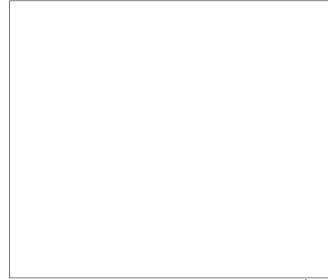
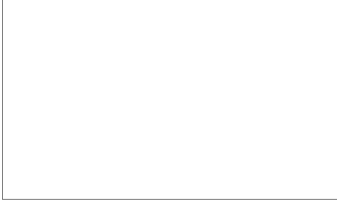

On 27 Feb 54, twelve Soviet twin-jet planes were observed engaged in starting and landing at the Klotsche Airfield, Bredten. The tail assembly resembled that of the MIG 15. The jets were in the wing tips. MIG 15s and eleven two-engined transport planes are stationed at the field. Three MIG 9s apparently are used as training planes for new pilots. About 250 men are stationed at the field.
