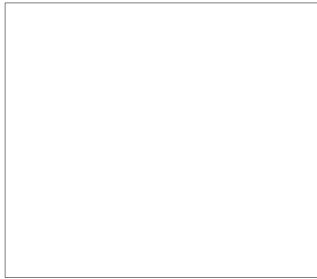

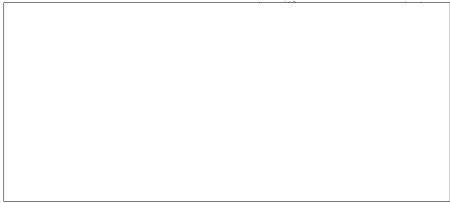

1. **Zeiss Ikon, of Dresden, produced about 8,000 proximity fuses in February 1954 which were shipped to the Soviet Union, probably by airplane.**
2. **Eight completely automatic target cameras were manufactured, also for the Soviet Union, but have not been shipped because Zeiss Jena has not yet delivered the electric exposure meters.**
3. **There has been no change in the production of curve potentiometers and parts for torpedoes.**
