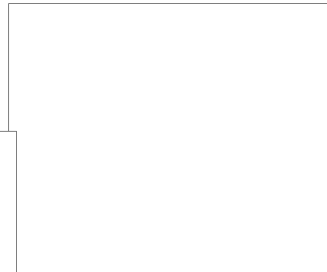

1. The thio-di-glycol produced at the Buna-Schkopau works is shipped weekly to Rostock and there loaded on Soviet ships. Reportedly, it is further treated in Leningrad. It is supposed that it is used to make mustard gas, because mustard gas was manufactured at Buna until 1951.
2. The required quota for the production of acetylene at Buna-Schkopau was 30,620 kg. (not tons) per month. The quota filled (October 1953) was 12,240 kg.
