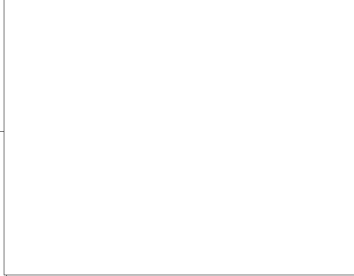
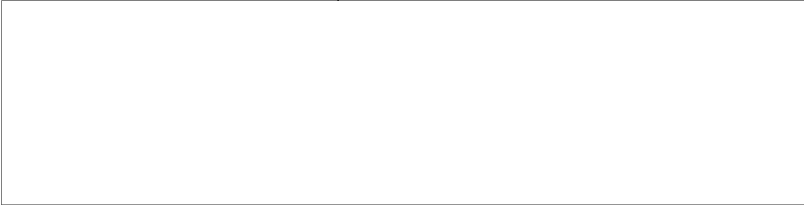

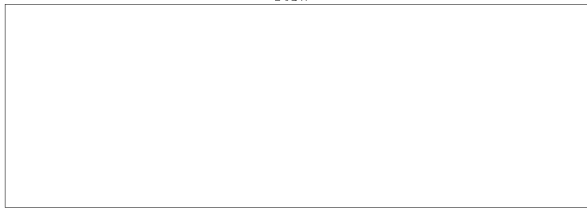

1. Development work has been finished on the sonic depth indicator with a range of 10 km and practical tests in the Baltic will begin at the end of May 1954. The Seepolizei will supply a boat.
2. Another type **KN3** Sea sender has been finished for the USSR. This one will not be mounted at a shipyard in the East Zone but will go to Leningrad. The frequencies of this sender are: 3-6MHz, 6-12 MHz, and 12-24 MHz, fully adjustable.
