The hospital does not meet the patients need for "Isonicotinic acid hydrazide". Some patients receive this medicine from home by mail. [Redacted]

[Redacted] the medicine is not made in North Korea. [Redacted] this medicine comes from America, Russia and Bulgaria. Isonicotinic acid made in America can be bought in Kaeso'ng. (Coord BT 8504) for 8,000 Wo'n. [Redacted]

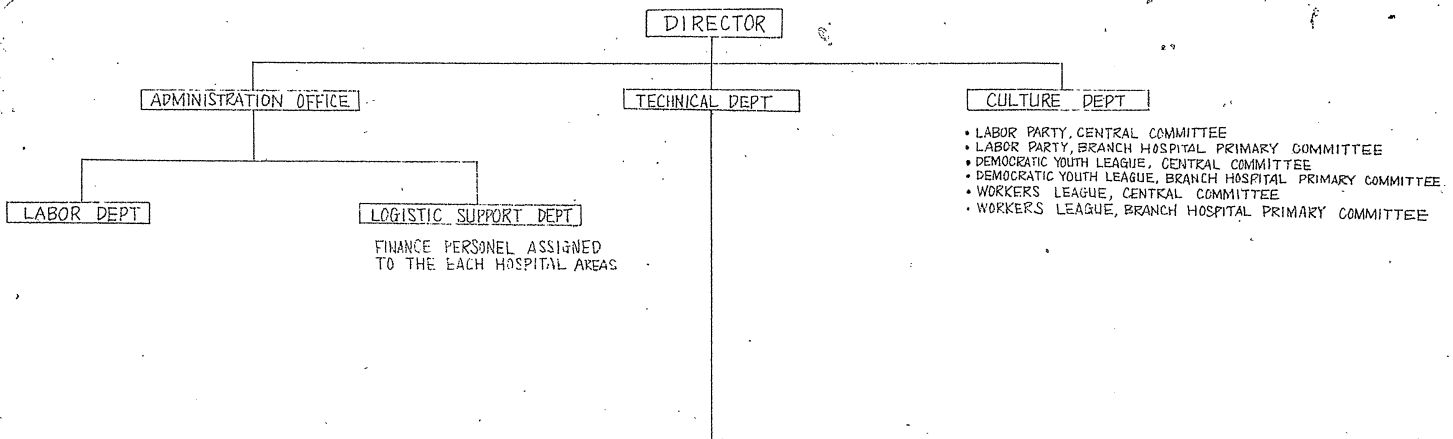
