1. With the consolidation of all of Hungary's electric companies and their facilities in 1948, the Ministry of Energy concentrated on Budapest's old and overworked system. An intensive reconstruction and new construction program was begun under the direction of the Budapest Municipal Electric Enterprise. Most of the new construction consisted of 35 KV transformer stations. 50X1-HUM
2. As of November 1956, four new 35 KV substations were in operation and six others under construction. In addition, the National Electric Transmission Enterprise (OVIT) had four new 120 KV transformer substations in operation as of November 1956.
