MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Concurrence in Contract No. LW-473 with The Perkin-Elmer Corporation, Norwalk, Conn., [redacted]  
Project AQUATONE

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1. This memorandum contains a recommendation submitted for approval of the Project Director. Such recommendation is set forth in Paragraph 4.

2. Contract No. LW-473 provides for top-level technical support primarily on the "B" and "C" configurations but not limited thereto for Project AQUATONE equipment. The contract is of a Time-and-Material type providing for services from 25 November 1957 to 30 June 1958. A sum of [redacted] is to be obligated during Fiscal Year 1958 against AQUATONE funds. By concurrence to this memorandum, the Project Comptroller signifies that sufficient funds are available for this additional obligation.

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3. Certification of funds for this contract will be handled under the procedure approved by the Director of Central Intelligence on 15 December 1956, which in effect results in all 10(b) expenses involving issuance of Treasury Checks being accumulated in a separate account within the Finance Division. The amounts in this account will be periodically scheduled for certification of the vouchers by the Director. This procedure eliminates the necessity for a separate certification of authority under Section 10(b) of Public Law 110, 81st Congress, for each contract.

4. Approval of Contract No. LW-473 and execution thereof on behalf of the Agency by the authorized Project Contracting Officer is recommended.
