Please proceed with the furnishing of the following items:

Nine (9) each - Light-weight coveralls with highvisibility panels. Part No. S-633L.

Nine (9) each - Intermediate-weight coveralls with high-wisibility panels. Part No. S62L.

One of each type of the above coveralls is to be furnished to the following FOG personnel: 60, 65, 66, 70, 71, 80, 135, 142 and 143. It is understood that your subcontractor, David Clark Co., already has made suits of each type for people and that the above requirements were discussed with David Clark by FOG representatives on 22 and 23 October 1957. Upon completion, each suit should be properly identified by code number and shipped to Project "Dragon Lady", Warner Robins AMA, Robins A.F.B., Ga. Mark for: Warshouse 17, Storeroom "B".

It is also requested that you "Mock-up" one seat kit using a standard AF container which is being sent to you by people. This is to be made for use with FOG ejection seat modification. The configuration is to be as discussed by Russ and you on 16 October. It should include provisions for interchangeable left or right suit attachment and an emergency system activation by a handle on the forward edge of the kit. The emergency activation handle cannot be in the center of the kit as this will interfere with the ejection handle. The kit should be made with a view to exchanging components from the old kits with a minimum new procurement.

25X1A It is also requested that you inspect and repair as necessary and at the seas time modify it to include an emergency oxygen activation on the front of the kit.

When this work is complete, Russ and Sid will visit Buffalo to inspect both kits.


