SUBJECT: Additional Personal Equipment for FOG

TO: Contracting Officer

Dear Dan:

The FOG using organization has submitted a requirement for a quantity of nine each light-weight and nine each intermediate-weight coveralls with high-visibility panels. David Clark Company, the manufacturer, already has made suits of each type for [redacted] people and has informed me that the costs are approximately \$105 for the light-weight suit (Part No. S-633L) and \$143 for the intermediate-weight suit (Part No. S-632L).

It is requested that authorization be given to Firewel for the procurement from [redacted] of nine coveralls of each type. The following numbers serve to identify the FOG personnel who are to receive them: 60, 65, 66, 70, 71, 80, 135, 142, and 143. One suit of each type should be made for each individual. [redacted] indicated to us in telephone conversations on 22 and 23 October that the first of these suits can be ready for delivery about two weeks after receipt of go-ahead.
