For your information the following is listed as standard procedure to be followed in submitting all travel claims:

- 3. Time should be shown on a 24 hour basis, i.e. 3 p.m. should be shown as 1500; 5 a.m. should be shown as 0500; forty-five minutes after midnight should be shown as 0045.
- 4. When crossing the international date line the dates and times in the local area of arrival and departure should be shown.
- 5. Receipts evidencing payments of claims shown should be attached or a reasonable explanation should be shown for the absence of receipts.
  - 6. The traveler should sign the travel claim.
