Dear George:

The Communications Division currently employs one field engineer, whose duties in connection with the testing of System 1 have required him to be at the remote test site four or five days per week, most weeks since testing began September 12.

It has been the Company's practice in other Divisions to pay men assigned to remote locations for test purposes some additional compensation based on the nature of the work to be performed, conditions at the field location and increased responsibility associated with being the Company's representative at such tests. These considerations are separate from those of travel and the necessity of establishing a separate residence where that is required.

We propose to compensate our field engineer with a 10% additional allowance for the time he is actually at a remote test site; such compensation to be retroactive. This rate seems appropriate to other similar circumstances in the Company and to the practice of a number of other companies.
