25X1	After checking with NFAC/CSS, I told Dick that there was no such publication (on U.S. oil usage statistics and, furthermore, the figures cited in Anderson's column are inaccurate). I added that, in any event, any figures that CIA might publish on U.S. oil usage or reserves are based on Department of Energy statistics rather than our own knowledge or analysis. This fully satisfied Mr. Giza.
