However, I explained that sub-project 74 encompassed a number of project proposals and Mr. McClelland appeared to be interested in only one of the subjects contained in the sub-project, which we could possibly provide him without any copying charges. I further explained that the subject material contains only the project proposal and there is no report in our files providing the results of the testing. Mr. Packer said he would be in touch with tomorrow and advise me how we should 25X1 proceed with the request. LIAISON Took a call from Ken Klein, 25X1 Counsel, House Select Committee on Intelligence, who reiterated a request for access to the report. I indicated that 25X1 **₹5**X1 OLC, would return his call with an update on the request. 25X1 LIAISON Took a call from Jackie Hess, Deputy Chief Research, House Select Committee on Intelligence, who requested priority searches on 14 individuals.
