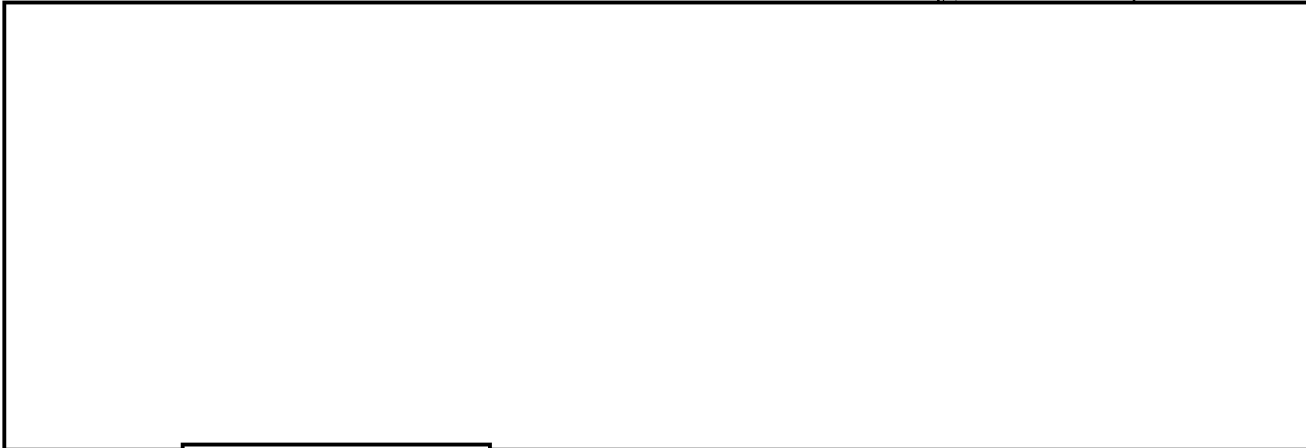

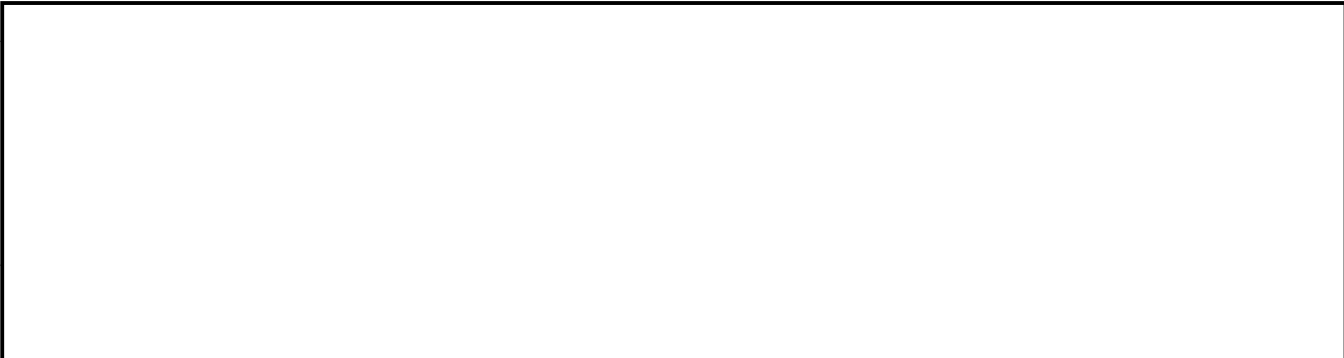

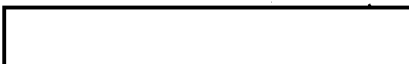

met with Dr. Charles Sheldon, Soviet space expert at the Library of Congress, and showed him examples of noncompartmented Agency publications on Soviet space activities which we will be providing to him on a regular basis. Dr. Sheldon said he felt such publications should satisfy his requirements. OWI will start sending the material to the NASA reading room for Dr. Sheldon's review under existing arrangements. I informed Dr. Sheldon that we would send letters to NASA and to Chairman Don Fuqua (D., Fla.), House Science and Technology Subcommittee on Space Science and Applications, confirming the arrangements, including prior CIA review of any unclassified studies that Dr. Sheldon may publish based on CIA information.
