1. (Unclassified - ME) FOIA/LIAISON I called Mr. Joseph Sisk, in the office of Representative Henry S. Reuss (D., Wisc.) concerning the Congressman's most recent inquiry on behalf of [redacted] 25X1 [redacted] 15 May 1978). I explained that the final response to [redacted] 25X1 was now in the hands of our Office of General Counsel, who are deep in FOIA litigation. The General Counsel's office needs to review it and the letter should be going out to [redacted] in about two weeks. 25X1 Mr. Sisk responded that the letter was only a routine check and I promised I would call him as soon as the letter goes out. 25X1

(Unclassified - RJK) LIAISON Helen Mattas, House International Relations Committee staff, requested the Agency publications, "Value Added by Work Brigades in Railroad and Highway Construction in China (1952-1957)", "China: Real Trends in Trade with Non-Community Countries Since 1970", "China: 1977 Midyear Grain Outlook", and "China Oil Production Prospects."
