- 22. (Unclassified DFM) ADMINISTRATIVE DELIVERIES Delivered to Susan Mahler, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, a letter transmitting a report on the Intelligence Community for Senator Birch Bayh (D., Ind.), Committee Chairman.
- 23. (Unclassified HMS) LIAISON Received a call from Holmes Brown, in the office of Senator Floyd Haskell (D., Colo.), requesting topographical maps of Egypt, Jordan, Syria, Israel and an inclusive map of the Middle East. I told him they would be sent to him.
