I told Eisenhower a decision on who would present the briefing to the Committee would not be made until after the DCI session. Regarding the request of 25X1 former Agency employee, to the Committee for assistance in pursuing his grievances with the Agency, I informed Eisenhower that there was no 25X1 incident in career other than the one Eisenhower was aware of which had affected 25X1 career progression. Eisenhower said it would be helpful to him and other members of the Committee to have a chart showing the incumbents in the senior Agency positions over the past 20 years or so. I agreed to get this for him. 25X1 LIAISON Called Stan Taylor, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, to inform him of information I had found out about 25X1 Taylor requested a briefing from DDO officials on possible international Communist support for the Red Brigades.
