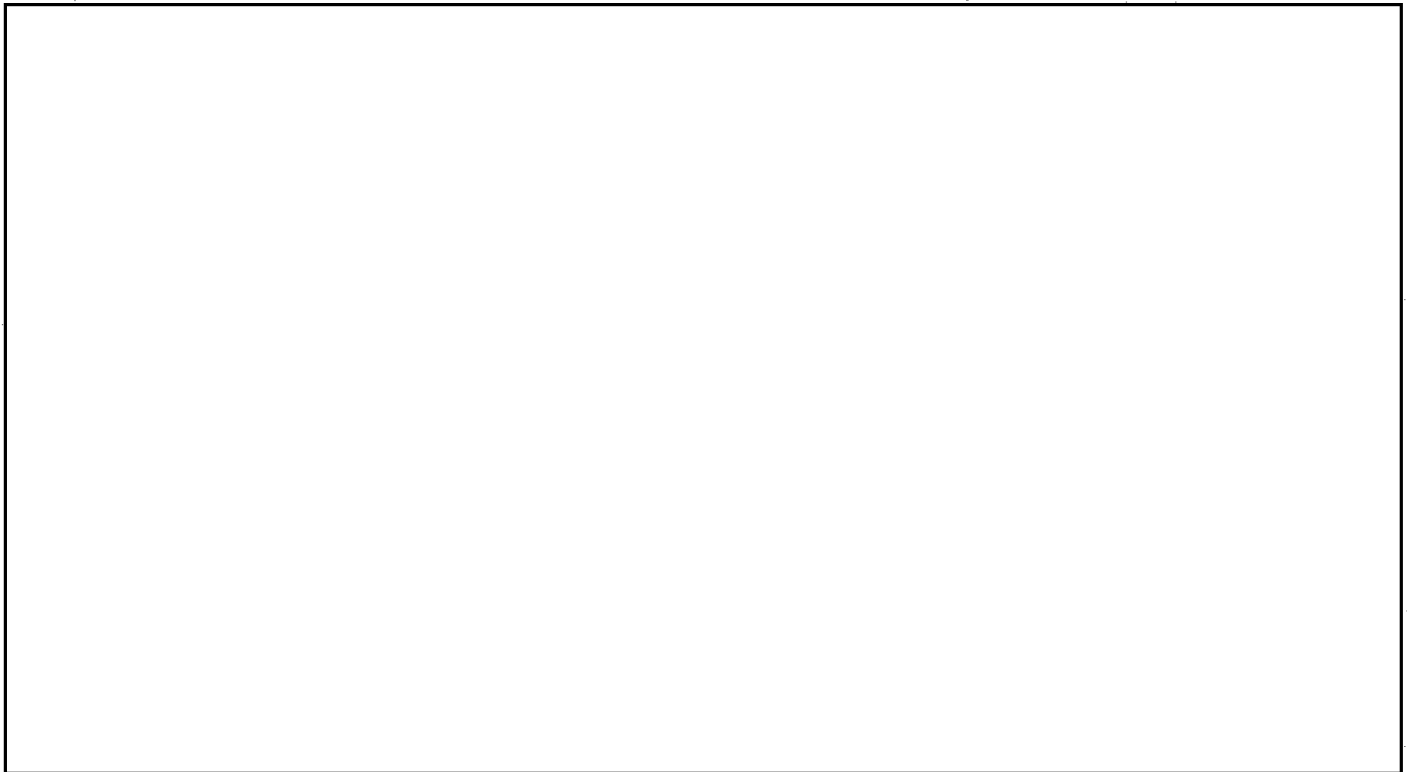

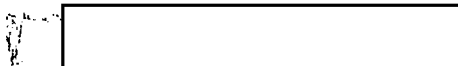

22. [Redacted] LIAISON Accompanied Stan Taylor, Catherine Essoyan, Abram Shulsky and Angelo Codevilla, all of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, to a briefing by LA Division/DDO representatives, headed by [Redacted] LA Division Chief, on LA Division anti-terrorist activities. Eight other LA Division personnel participated, giving summaries of terrorist problems in particular countries in the region. [Redacted] O/SA/DO/O, also sat in. Later Taylor informed me that this was an excellent briefing and that the team working on the study of Government anti-terrorist programs had now received all the overall briefings they needed and were ready to go to work on individual assignments in this field.

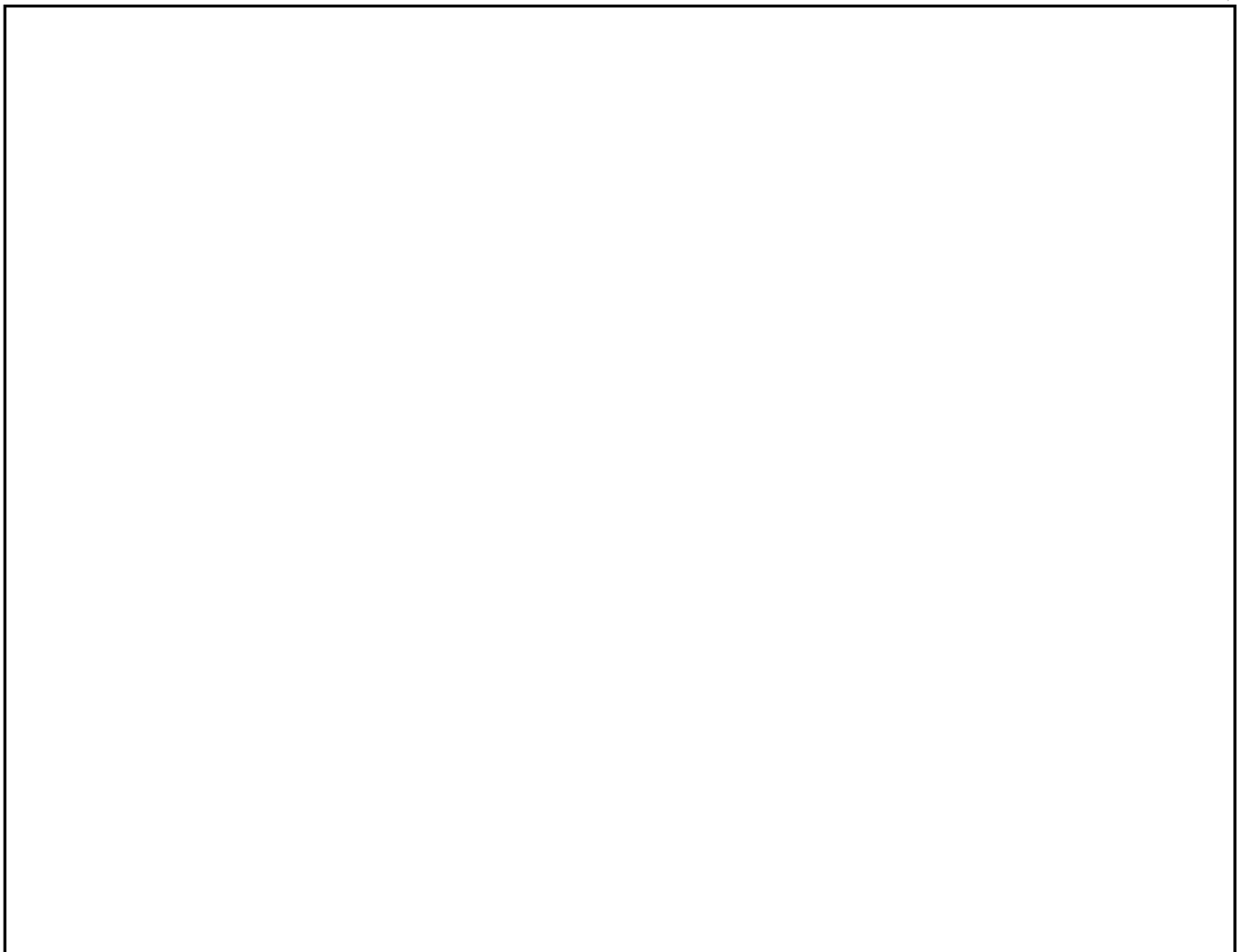
