SUBJECT: Comments on Counterinsurgency Surveillance--Comments on the Utility of Mobile Sensory Techniques (U)

Per your request listed below are the comments made by two PI's in IAD on the subject document:

25X1 A fairly good assessment of the use of aerial photography against insurgent operations. I have serious reservations regarding the value of visual observation although. When considering U.S. pilot reports on bomb damage assessment over North Vietnam and [redacted] reports of trucking activity in the Laos Panhandle (both of which are, in part, unconfirmable on low-level photography) I believe that the authors may have been too kind.
