After Austria's occupation by the Nazis, Philipp von Schoeller was made a member of the Board of Directors of the Credit-Anstalt-Bank-versin. This is interesting because the Reich Government became the owner of 76% of the shares of this largest Austrian credit institution. The changes in the bank personnel were characterized by the removal of all anti-Nazi or Jowish officers and umployees and their replacement by trusted German and Austrian party members. Austrian Industry was represented by eight members. One of them was Philipp von Schoeller.

Another interesting nomination was that into the Board of Directors of the "Alpen-Elektrowerke" which took over most public utilities

formerly owned by the Industrie-Kreditbank. Only two Austrian members were called into that Board: Philipp von Schooller and Erica Holler (Creditanstalt).

Philipp von Schoeller thus became one of the most influential capitalists of Austria, but this influence (and also his income) was even enhanced by certain business transactions.

One of the most profitable transactions of this kind was the acquisition of the Vösiauer Kammgarnfabrik. This transaction was carried out with the help of a Munich Nazi firm which had played a role at the time of the itquidetion of the house of kethschild. Schoeller & Co., together with that Munich firms Merck, Finck & Co. (general manager Baron Kitter) "boutht" the majority of the shares of the Vösiauer Kammgarnfabrik, which was one of the largest Central European textile concerns.

In this manner Philipp von Schoeller became one of the most prominent profiteers of the Nazi regime in Austria.
